**Explanations:****1.**

In option C, 'holds' must be replaced with 'held' to match the tense of the principal clause.

Hence, option C is correct.

**2.**

In part C, two negatives 'without' and 'none' can't go together. 'None' hence must be replaced with 'any' to make it a grammatically correct sentence.

Hence, option C is correct.

**3.**

In option D, 'what' must be replaced by 'how' for the sentence to make sense.

Hence, option D is correct.

**4.**

In part C, 'provide' must be replaced with 'provided' as the sentence is in passive voice and past participle of the verb is required for the sentence to be grammatically correct.

Hence, option C is correct.

**5.**

Under the context, the phrase 'more of' must be replaced with the prepositional phrase 'more than', which means 'over', to make it a grammatically correct sentence.

Hence, option B is correct.



**6.**

The noun 'shortage' is generally followed by the preposition 'of' and not 'for'. The correct formation will be- There is a shortage of qualified staff in many software companies in India.

Hence, option B is correct.

**7.**

As Reserve Bank of India is a single entity, therefore, 'is' should be used in place of 'are'.

Hence, option A is correct.

**8.**

The sentence is absolutely correct and thus has no error in it.

Option E is hence the correct answer.

**9.**

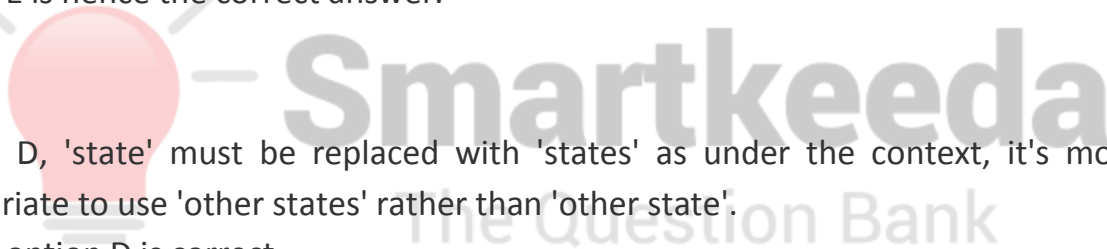
In part D, 'state' must be replaced with 'states' as under the context, it's more appropriate to use 'other states' rather than 'other state'.

Hence, option D is correct.

**10.**

In part C, there would be no use of 'yet' at all. It, hence, will be omitted to make the sentence a grammatically correct one.

Hence, option C is correct.





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
