The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-D:

The share of imports in India's oil consumption has risen sharply in the last two decades. The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

The baby has a cute face primarily made of jute and cotton.

The sentence doesn't make any sense. The pair B-F is hence invalid.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

2. Checking A-F:

Small scale industries comprise units involved in manufacturing, processing and preservation of goods.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-D:

The bilateral meeting between the three leaders went as planned.

The above sentence is incorrect. "Trilateral" meeting takes place between 'three' countries whereas "bilateral" meeting takes place between 'two' countries.

Hence, the pair B-D is valid.

Checking C-E:

He's my sister's husband donuts being served.

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair C-E is valid.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

3. Checking B-D:

India has had a rich tradition of philanthropy by industrialists.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking A-F:

With the help of Mingle app, the customers can avail various banking services through the official facebook page of SBI.

The above sentence is also correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-E:

The sentence doesn't make any sense contextually. The pair C-E is hence invalid.

Mizo Puanchei is made by weavers by inserting designs and motifs by using supplementary yarns while weaving to create this beautiful and alluring textile.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

Google found the green was hard to read, especially for people with visual impairments.

The above sentence is also correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-D:

Sam yelled at Mary recovered from her injury.

The sentence doesn't make any sense. The pair C-D is hence invalid.

Option C is hence the correct answer.



7. Checking C-D:

The above sentence is incorrect grammatically as the phrase 'one of' is always followed by a plural noun which is not the case here. Hence, the pair C-D is valid.

Checking A-E:

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

A cyclical slowdown has to be tackled with measures to stimulate demand. The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

Our medical devices market relies heavily on imports, and there is a reason why this is so.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking C-E:

She asked me to take a look at it screamed out of the room.

The sentence doesn't make any sense contextually. The pair C-E is hence invalid.

Checking A-F:

The 'World Photography Day' is being observed to inspire photographers across the planet.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option C is hence the correct answer.



9. Checking A-F:

NEDL is a complete list of diagnostic tests, medical devices and in-vitro diagnostic devices for all levels of health care.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-D:

He didn't answer at first

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually as well.

Checking C-E:

Patriotism is the last resort of the scoundrel but slowly opened up.

The above sentence too is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

10. Checking A-E:

The term 'priority sector' indicates those activities which have national importance and have been assigned priority for development.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Checking B-F:

Efforts are also on to make Japan and South Korea, the world's fourth and fifth biggest oil importer, to join the bloc.

The above sentence is grammatically incorrect. In fragment F instead of 'importer', 'importers' should have been used. Hence, the pair B-F is invalid.

Checking C-D:

It'll be ready by Monday they joined hands.

The sentence doesn't make any sense. The pair C-D is hence invalid.

Option A is hence the correct answer.
