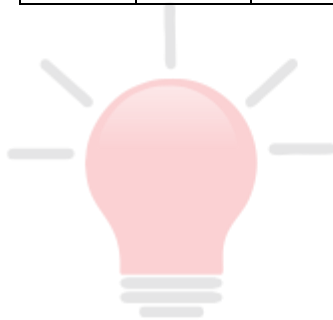

The above sentence is grammatically erroneous. The correct preposition after 'grabbed' would be 'onto'. Hence, the pair B-F is invalid.

### Checking C-D:

Freelancing has always been a popular way to earn money online in spite of the Internet has a plethora of options.

The above sentence is grammatically erroneous. The usage of 'in spite of' in the above sentence is incorrect. The correct word in front of 'the internet' would be 'and' instead of the expression 'in spite of'. Hence, the pair C-D is invalid.

Hence, option E is the correct answer.

### 2. Checking A-E:

The audience gave the veteran musician a standing ovation.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair A-E is valid.

### Checking B-D:

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair B-D is valid.

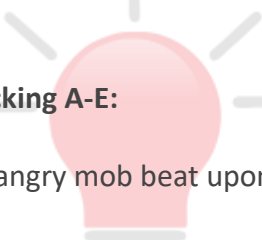
The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually. Hence, the pair B-D is valid.

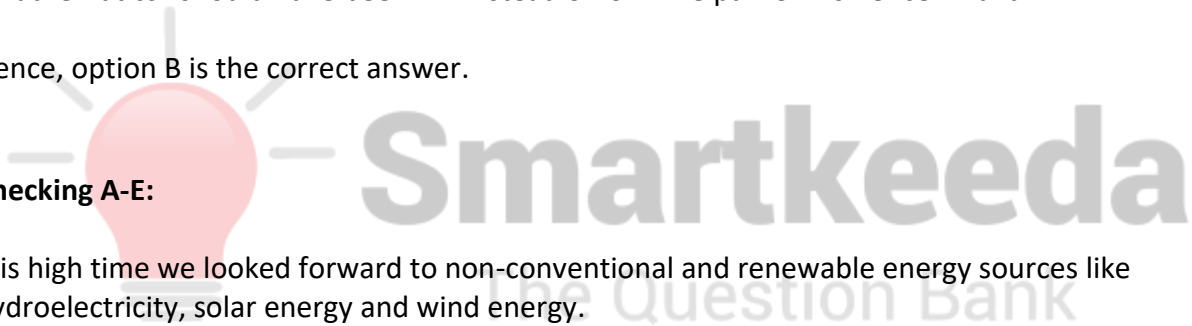
The usage of "while" is erroneous here. The word "when" would have been correct in place of "while" here. "While" denotes 'a period of time' which is incongruous here. Hence the pair B-D is invalid.

**Checking C-F:**

Large number of rural people and students belonging to poorer sections of society cannot avail to these benefits of internet and virtual education.

The usage of the preposition "to" is erroneous after avail. "Avail" never takes 'to' after it. In some instances, 'avail' may be followed by 'of'. Hence, the pair C-F is invalid.

Hence, option A is the correct answer.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

**Checking B-D:**

The usage of "from" after introduced is erroneous. The correct preposition after introduced would have been 'in'. Hence the pair B-D is invalid.

The above sentence is correct both grammatically and contextually.

Hence, option D is the correct answer.

**8. Checking A-F:**

The usage of "responsibly" is erroneous in the given sentence. "Responsibly" is an adverb, but the sentence demands an adjective in place of "responsibly". "Responsible" would have been correct in place of "responsibly". Hence, the pair A-F is invalid.

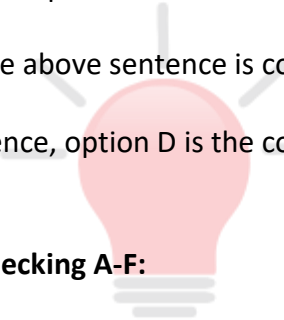
