## Explanations:

1. First, third, fourth, sixth, eighth and ninth letters of "ASTRONAUT" are – A,T,R,N,U and T.

Truant is the only meaningful English word which can be formed using the above letters.

'U' is the third letter of the word Truant.

Hence option B is correct.

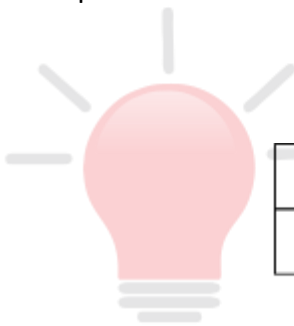
2. Only "Lure" can be formed using the letters of the word "SQUIRREL" .

Rest words possess some extra letters.

Lure means to tempt or provoke someone.

Hence option D is correct.

**Fifth letter of the word: T**

**Tenth letter of the word: H**

Hence, letters between T and H in English alphabet = 11

Hence, the correct answer is option D.

5. We have,

The given word = ABHINANDAN

Possible pair of letters in the above word which has as many letters between them as in the English alphabetical series **as we move only from left to right**:

A	B
A	B

H	I
H	I

Clearly, only two such pairs that meet the given conditions are possible.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

6. Observing the table, we can say that only M's position remains unchanged.

Hence, the correct answer is option B.

7. The given word = RETIREMENT

After arranging all the letters in alphabetical order from left to right end, we get:

EEEIMNRRTT

At this point, we have:

<b>Given word</b>	R	E	T	I	R	E	M	E	N	T
<b>After arranging</b>	E	E	E	I	M	N	R	R	T	T

Here, we can see that position of three letters is same in both words.

Hence, the correct answer is option **D**.

8.

9. **While counting from left to right**, we get only one such pair that satisfies the condition. The pair is as follows:

<b>P</b>	<b>E</b>	<b>R</b>
P	Q	R

Option B is hence the correct answer.

10. Words that can be formed using O, U, S and L while keeping S as the first letter: **SOUL**

Clearly, option B is the correct answer.



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
