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Explanation:

1. 1st and 5th alphabets of SMART are S and T respectively.

4th and 5th alphabets of FANCY are C and Y respectively.

Word formed with letters, S, T, C and Y is CYST.

The 3rd letter in CYST is S.

Hence, option B is correct.

2. **Given word** – M A D A G A S C A R

After applying condition – N B E B H B T D B S

1st, 3rd, 7th, 8th and 10th alphabets are N, E, T, D and S respectively.

The possible words from these alphabets are DENTS and TENDS.

Hence, option D is correct.

3. **Given word** – METICULOUSLY

After applying condition - N F U J D V M P V T M Z

3rd, 4th, 8th and 11th alphabets are U, J, P and M respectively.

The possible word which can be formed using these alphabets is JUMP.

Hence, option C is correct.

4. **Given word** – V O R A C I O U S N E S S

After applying condition – U P R B C J P V S O F S S

1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 9th and 13th letters are U, R, B, C, S and S respectively.

The possible word which can be formed using these alphabets is SCRUBS.

Hence, option C is correct.

5. Given word: EXHAUSTED

New word: DXGATSSEC.

Clearly, we can see there are 4 such pairs.

Thus, option D is correct.

6. 3rd, 4th and 7th letters of the word 'SUPERFLUOUS' → P, E and L

1st, 4th and 7th letters of the word 'LOFTINESS' → L, T and E

1st, 3rd and 4th letters of the word 'ANAPHORA' → A, A and P

The word formed with these letters is APPELLATE.

4th letter from right = L

Hence, option B is correct.

7. In this word "PERCEPTION" if we arrange according to the instruction given above, we can get the new arrangement as "OFQBFOSJPM".

So, now the letter F is 5th from the left and S is 4th letter from the right. So, according to the English alphabetical series, there are 12 letters in between them (G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q and R).

Hence option A is correct.

8. References:

- M is fourth to the right of N.
- Three letters are there between D and K.
- Neither K nor D is adjacent to either N or M.
- The second last vowel is written second to the left of S.
- G is written second to the right of the third last vowel.
- Two letters are written between I and D.
