Who: Actor Kishore Nandlaskar

What: passes away

When: published on 21st April 2021

Veteran actor Kishore Nandlaskar, who featured in several Marathi and Hindi films like 'Purna Satya' and 'Jis Desh Mein Ganga Rehta Hai', died on Tuesday due to COVID-19 complications. He was 81.

Nandlaskar was admitted to Global COVID centre in Thane last week after he tested positive for the novel coronavirus.

"He was admitted in the ICU last week. He died due to COVID-19 complications today around 12.30 pm," Nandlaskar's grandson Anish told PTI.

Nandlaskar is survived by his wife and three sons.

The actor made his debut in 1982 with Marathi film 'Navare Sagle Gadhav' and went to act in movies like 'Bhavishyachi Aishi Taishi: The Prediction', 'Gaon Thor Pudhari Chor' and 'Jara Japun Kara'.(Read more)

Who: Former U.S. Vice President Walter Mondale

What: dies at 93

Walter Mondale, a leading liberal Democratic voice of the late 20th century who was U.S. vice president under Jimmy Carter and lost in a landslide to Ronald Reagan in the 1984 presidential election, died on Monday at age 93, his family said.

"Well my time has come. I am eager to rejoin Joan and Eleanor," Mondale said in a statement to his staff and released to the public after his death, referring to his late wife Joan, who died in 2014, and daughter Eleanor, who died in 2011 at age 51. "Before I go I wanted to let you know how much you mean to me."

Mondale, the first major U.S. party presidential nominee to pick a woman running mate, believed in an activist government and worked for civil rights, school integration, consumer protection and farm and labor interests as a U.S. senator and vice president during Carter's troubled one-term presidency from 1977 to 1981.(Read more)

What: clears Silk Board-Airport metro line, to complete in 54 months

When: published on 20th April 2021

The Union Cabinet on Tuesday cleared Bangalore Metro Rail's ambitious Silk Board to international airport line project, which is estimated to cost about Rs 14,788 crore.

The Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation (BMRCL) is implementing the project in two phases. While phase 2A covers Central Silk Board Junction to K.R. Puram, the phase 2B runs from K.R. Puram to Airport via Hebbal Junction. The two phases cover a length of 58.19 km.

Thirteen stations over a length of 19.75 km come under phase 2A, while 17 stations over a stench of 38.44 km fall under phase 2B. Once completed in the estimated 54 months, this project will play a key role in decongesting the city which contributes 40% to India's It exports & is home to a large number of IT parks, hubs and industries, Union Urban Affairs minister Hardeep Singh Puri tweeted.(Read more)

In the latest World Press Freedom Index, the watchdog said that while India has not slipped further from its position at 142 out of 180 countries, it continues to be classified as "bad" for journalism – a title it shares with nations such as Brazil, Mexico and Russia.(Read more)

Indian Army chief General MM Naravane on Sunday attended the Army Chiefs' Conclave held in Dhaka, on the sidelines of a multinational military exercise.

General Naravane, who is in Bangladesh on a five-day official tour, delivered a keynote address on "Changing Nature of Global Conflicts: Role of UN Peacekeepers", the Indian Army's additional directorate general of public information (ADG PI) tweeted.

During the event, the Army chief also interacted with the senior officers of the participating nations and military observers from the other nations.

The Shantir Ogroshena (Frontrunners of Peace) 2021 exercise commenced on April 4 at Bangabandhu Senanibas to commemorate the birth centenary of Bangladesh's 'Father of the Nation' Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and mark 50 years of the country's liberation from Pakistan.(Read more)

What: to host first ever WBC India Championship on 1 May

When: published on 20th April 2021

In what is being billed as a game-changer for professional boxing in the country, the World Boxing Council (WBC) has endorsed the Indian championship fight between Chandni Mehra and Suman Kumari on 1 May in Jalandhar.

The fight for the lightweight 140lb belt is scheduled to take place as part of the LZ Promotions India Unleashed-Fight Night - the country's first-ever Professional USA boxing event, according to a release.

Chandni and Suman have been India's No 1 fighters in lightweight and featherweight categories and now will be challenging each other in this bout, aiming to become the first-ever WBC India champion across both men and women categories.

The WBC is one of the four major organisations that sanctions professional boxing bouts globally.

This is the first time ever that India will be hosting a title card sanctioned by the global body and contested by the two female fighters.(Read more)

Who: AP CM

What: credits Rs 128.47 cr under YSR Zero-Interest Crop Loan

When: published on 20th April 2021

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy on Tuesday credited Rs 128.47 crore directly into the accounts of 6,27,906 farmers under 'YSR Zero-Interest Crop Loan Scheme' for 2019-20 Rabi season benefiting those who availed loans up to Rs one lakh and repaid them in the stipulated time.

Addressing the beneficiaries and officials through video conference, the Chief Minister said that since the government came to power in June 2019, a total of Rs 1,132 crore had been paid to 61,22,585 under the zero-interest subsidy scheme. He urged the farmers to get enrolled under the e-crop database for availing interest subvention from June 2021.

The Chief Minister said that the government has been providing nine-hour free electricity to the farmers during day time benefiting over 18.78 lakh farmers by spending Rs.8,800 crore annually. 'Through this scheme, each farmer will be saving a minimum of Rs 46,000 every year. The State government has completed the capacity building of feeders to provide free power to farmers with a cost of Rs 1,700 crores,' he informed.

Besides these, the government is providing input subsidy to the farmers to cover the losses in the same crop season and credited Rs 1055 crore. In regard to crop insurance, the government has taken the responsibility of paying the insurance premium, providing insurance to the farmers on a timely basis. Also, the State government has set up a market intervention fund with Rs 3,000 crore and is providing a minimum support price for the crops to aid farmers. (Read more)

What: dies visiting front-line troops: Army

Chad's longtime President Idriss Deby has died of wounds suffered on the front line in the country's north, where he had gone to visit soldiers battling rebels, the armed forces said.

Deby, 68, "has just breathed his last defending the sovereign nation on the battlefield" over the weekend, army spokesman General Azem Bermandoa Agouna said in a statement read out on state television on Tuesday, a day after Deby was declared the winner of a presidential election.

The exact circumstances of Deby's death were not immediately clear. The army said the president had been commanding his army at the weekend as it battled rebels who had launched a major incursion into the north of the country on election day on April 11.(Read more)

Who: Mahamat Idriss Deby Itno

What: has been named as the President of Chad

Lt Gen Mahamat Idriss Déby Itno has been named as the new leader of Chad, after his father Idriss Déby was killed during a battle with rebel forces.

Mahamat is now in charge of a 15-member Transitional Military Council (CMT) that will be in power for the next 18 months.

He has a reputation for discretion and shunning the limelight, unlike some of his half-brothers. However, he is a battle-hardened soldier like his father.

Mahamat, 37, is the same age as the late Déby was when he took power through a military coup in 1990.(Read more)
