What: partners with Northern Arc Capital for first pooled bond issuance

The CDC Group, a development finance institution (DFI) and an impact investor in the UK, has partnered with Northern Arc Capital for its first-ever pooled bond issuance (PBI) transaction in India. The PBI worth Rs 320 crore will support six leading Indian microfinance institutions.

CDC's investment in the transaction is supported by a partial guarantee provided by Northern Arc. It is a milestone for CDC as it is the first transaction structured by CDC under a PBI structure, according to a release.

CDC's Rs 320 crore investment in a pool of senior secured NCDs will provide systemic liquidity to the six leading Indian microfinance institutions including Annapurna Finance, Arohan Financial Services, ASA International, Asirvad Microfinance Limited, Chaitanya India and Fusion Microfinance.(Read more)

National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) recently announced the formation of its wholly-owned subsidiary firm – NPCI Bharat BillPay Ltd (NBBL). The newly set up entity came into effect from April 1, 2021.

What: directs RBI to retain inflation target of 4% till March 2026

When: published on 1st April 2021

The Centre has directed the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to retain the inflation target of 4% with a tolerance of 2% on either side for another five-year period ending March 2026.

Earlier in 2016, the government had allowed RBI to keep the consumer price index (CPI) inflation target at 4% with upper and lower tolerance of 2% for a five-year period ending March 31, 2021.

As per a PTI report, the Economic Affairs Secretary Tarun Bajaj on Wednesday said, the inflation target for the period April 1, 2021, to March 31, 2026, under the Reserve Bank of India Act 1934 has been kept at the same level as was for previous 5 years.

Between October 2016-March 2020, the central bank has managed to hold the consumer price index at an average of 3.9%.(Read more)

What: Topped in Digital Payments with 25.5 Billion Real-Time Transactions in 2020: ACI Report 2021

When: published on 5th April 2021

According to a report, next few years are going to see rapid increase in digital payments. Also it is going to account for a 71.7 percent share of all the payments in India by 2025.

According to the report by ACI Worldwide, only 28.3 percent share will be occupied by cash and cheques, the other payment alternatives.

According to the report, in the year 2020 India with 25.5 billion real-time payments transactions was ahead of China 15.7 billion real-time payments transactions.(Read more)

What: mandatory in Invoices for Businesses with over INR 5 Crore Turnover: Finance Ministry

When: published on 31st March 2021

Businesses with turnover of more than Rs 5 crore will have to furnish six-digit HSN or tariff code on the invoices issued for supplies of taxable goods and services from April 1, the finance ministry said on Wednesday.

Those with turnover of up to Rs 5 crore in the preceding financial year would be required to mandatorily furnish four-digit HSN code on B2B invoices.(Read more)

What: to Launch Unique ID Number for All Plots of Land by 2022: Report

When: published on 29th March 2021

The Central government has plans to introduce 14-digit identification number for every plot of land in the country within a year, according to a report in The Hindu. The land records database will then reportedly be integrated with revenue court records and bank records, as well as Aadhaar numbers on a voluntary basis, the newspaper says.

This plan has been laid out in a parliamentary standing committee report submitted to the Lok Sabha last week, as part of the Digital India Land Records Modernisation Programme (DILRMP) which began in 2008 and has been expanded several times.

The Unique Land Parcel Identification Number (ULPIN) scheme, as it is being called, has already been rolled out in 10 states, the report quotes the Department of Land Resources, and will be extended across the country by March 2022. A department official told The Hindu that the ULPIN would be the "the Aadhaar for land" and be used to prevent land fraud.(Read more)

What: approves PLI scheme for food processing industry

When: published on 1st April 2021

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved the production linked incentives (PLI) scheme for food processing industry. Union Minister Piyush Goyal said that the PLI scheme for food processing will have an outlay of Rs 10,900 crore. The amount was approved earlier last year.

The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved the scheme which will help create 2.5 lakh jobs by 2026-27, boost exports and facilitate the expansion of food processing capacity to generate processed food output worth Rs 33,494 crore.

What: agree to revise India-US Strategic Energy Partnership (SEP)

When: published on 30th March 2021

India and the United States have agreed to revamp their strategic energy partnership to focus on greater collaboration in cleaner energy sectors such as biofuels, and hydrogen production, an Indian government said in a statement on Monday.

The statement was issued after a virtual meeting of Indian oil minister Dharmendra Pradhan and U.S. Energy Secretary Jennifer Granholm. The two countries will intensify efforts to take advantage of advanced U.S. technologies and India's rapidly growing energy market, it said.(Read more)

What: Extends Validity of ECLGS till June, 2021; ECLGS 3.0 Introduced to cover more Sectors

When: published on 31st March 2021



The government on Wednesday extended the Rs 3-lakh-crore emergency credit line guarantee scheme by another three months till June 30 and also widened its scope to new sectors, including hospitality, travel and tourism. ECLGS 3.0 would involve extending credit of up to 40 per cent of total credit outstanding across all lending institutions as on February 29, 2020, the finance ministry said in a statement.

The tenor of loans granted under ECLGS 3.0 would be 6 years ,including a moratorium period of 2 years.

"In recognition of the continuing adverse impact of COVID-19 pandemic on certain service sectors, the government has now extended the scope of ECLGS through introduction of ECLGS 3.0 to cover business enterprises in Hospitality, Travel & Tourism, Leisure & Sporting sectors which had, as on February 29, 2020, total credit outstanding not exceeding Rs 500 crore and overdues, if any, were for 60 days or less, on that date," it said.(Read more)

What: becomes first state to provide health insurance for all its residents

When: published on 1st April 2021

Rajasthan on Thursday became the first state in the country to provide health insurance for all its residents.

The state began registration for Mukhyamantri Chiranjeevi Swasthya Bima Yojana under which each family in the state can claim up to Rs five lakh a year for medical expenses.

Announcing about the launch of the scheme, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot tweeted, "Registrations for Rajasthan Govt's cashless treatment for all - Mukhyamantri Chiranjeevi Swasthya Bima Yojana have begun in the state from today. It is one of our biggest health care schemes aimed at providing medical relief to all residents of #Rajasthan." (Read more)

What: Discovered In Maharashtra Named After Sharad Pawar

A new species of flowering plants belonging to the genus 'Argyreia', recently discovered in south Maharashtra's Kolhapur district, has been named after National Congress Party (NCP) chief Sharad Pawar.

The species has been named 'Argyreia sharadchandrajii' in recognition of Mr Pawar's contribution as Union agriculture minister, said researchers Dr Pramod R Lawand and Dr Vinod B Shimpale.

Kolhapur district falls in the famous Western Ghats ecological zone, known for its rich biodiversity.

The new species was found in the Alamprabhu Dev-raai (sacred grove), said Mr Lawand and Mr Shimpale, who teach botany at a college in Kolhapur. (Read more)

Army.

BDL manufactures Akash Missiles both for the Indian Army and Indian Air Force. The Akash Weapon System, designed and developed by DRDO (Defence Research and Development Organisation) with 96% indigenous content, is being manufactured by BDL at its Hyderabad Unit with a large number of supply chain partners which include DPSUs, MSMEs and private industry.(Read more)

What: sells Santacruz HQ to Yes Bank to settle debt

When: published on 1st April 2021

Reliance Infrastructure has said that it has sold Reliance Centre – the premises housing the group's headquarters – to Yes Bank for Rs 1,200 crore.

"Entire proceeds from the sale of Reliance Centre, Santacruz, is utilized only to repay the debt of Yes Bank', the company said in a statement to the exchange.

In July, the private lender had taken symbolic possession of the sprawling complex situated off the Western Express Highway and overlooking the Mumbai airport. The action was taken under the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest (SARFAESI) Act to recover dues of Rs 2,892 crore from Anil Ambani's Reliance Infrastructure. In terms of the act, the bank has to give a two-month notice before taking possession, which the bank had done in May.(Read more)
