What: launches tip line to curb fake news ahead of Lok Sabha elections

When: published on 2nd April 2019

WhatsApp launched an India-focused fact-checking feature to combat fake news and rumours starting with the run-up to the Lok Sabha elections.

The initiative comes a day after Facebook, which owns WhatsApp, took down over 700 pages linked to individuals that it said were associated with the Congress and the Bharatiya Janata Party for spamming other users.

The messaging platform said that its Indian users, numbering more than 200 million, can now report uncertain information or rumours they have received to a WhatsApp number (+91-9643-000-888) and check its authenticity.

The response will indicate if information is classified as 'true', 'false', 'misleading', 'disputed' or 'out of scope', and include any other related information. WhatsApp will review pictures, video links or texts in Hindi, Telugu, Bengali, Malayalam and English.

Developed in collaboration with India-based media skilling startup PROTO, the tip line feature will help create a database of rumours to study

misinformation during elections as part of a research project commissioned and assisted by WhatsApp.

Chicago became the largest American city ever to elect a black woman as its mayor as voters chose Lori Lightfoot, a former prosecutor, to replace Rahm Emanuel. When she takes office in May, Ms. Lightfoot also will be the city's first openly gay mayor.

Ms. Lightfoot, who has never held elective office, easily won the race, overwhelming a better-known, longtime politician and turning her outsider status into an asset in a city with a history of corruption and insider dealings. Ms. Lightfoot, 56, beat Toni Preckwinkle, a former alderman who is president of the Cook County Board and who had for years been viewed as a highly formidable candidate for mayor.

BSNL and its satellite partner, Inmarsat, will be able to offer in-flight connectivity to airlines “later this year, once the ground infrastructure and associated approvals are in place,” said a press statement from Inmarsat.

Hughes Communications India Ltd., a subsidiary of a global company, and Tatanet Services have already bagged the Flight and Maritime Connectivity (FMC) licence. Bharti Airtel has also sought the permit.

The DoT had notified its rules in December allowing airlines flying within and transiting through India to provide Internet and voice services on mobile phones along with an Indian telecom operator or licensee. So far, SpiceJet has announced that it will offer Internet access to passengers. Vistara has evinced interest in this service.

According to the rules, passengers can make phone calls or use Internet when a flight is at a minimum height of 3,000 m in Indian airspace to avoid interference with terrestrial mobile networks.
