What: exported to London

When: published on 28th July 2021

On Wednesday, July 28, India sent a 250kg shipment of Bhut Jolokia to London, UK. Nagaland has exported the hottest chilli in the world, Bhut Jolokia, for the first time to London. "This is a major boost for exports of Geographical Indications (GI) products from the north-eastern region," according to the Press Information Bureau. Also known as "Raja Mircha" or Nagaland's King Chilli, Bhut Jolokia got its GI certification in the year 2008. A few chillies were exported to London via Guwahati this morning, as documented by the Press Information Bureau on Instagram.

"India's hottest chilies, #BhutJolokia make their way to #London," PIB wrote in the caption accompanying the pictures, which show boxes of the chilies getting ready to be shipped.

The fast bowler made his debut for England in 1973 against West Indies while his last match in international cricket came in 1981.

According to Nottinghamshire Club, after serving the county of his birth, Derbyshire, with distinction for 13 years, Hendrick spent the final three seasons of his career at Trent Bridge, taking 100 wickets in 34 First-Class matches at an average of 16.81 before an injury ended his playing career.

The "Pink Protection" project aims to prevent dowry-related issues, cyber-bullying and humiliation in public places. The project has 10 components, one of which is activating the existing Pink Police Patrol system.



The system has been named "Pink Janamaithri Beat", under which police officials will conduct regular house visits to collect information on domestic violence. They will collect information from panchayat members, neighbours and other locals and hand it over to the Station House Officers for further action.
