August 10 is observed as World Biofuel Day in honour of Sir Rudolf Diesel, inventor of the diesel engine. It was just one day before, on August 9 in 1893 that Sir Diesel, first successfully operated the mechanical engine with peanut oil. With this, he was able to predict the possibility of vegetable oil replacing fossil fuels as a feasible source of energy in the next century. To commemorate this achievement, the date was chosen to observe World Biofuel Day.

Biofuels are renewable and biodegradable sources of energy. By virtue of these qualities, they are more sustainable than their traditional counterparts. "Biofuel" is an umbrella term for any type of fuel that can be generated from biological material such as agricultural wastes, or vegetation including trees and crops. grass. The principle of biofuel is that it must be produced from a carbon source that can be replenished within a short interval of time. Additionally, biofuels have a lesser carbon footprint when compared to non-renewable fossil fuels.

When: published on 8th August 2021

Three days prior to the 75th Independece Day celebrations, India will launch its most advanced geoimaging satellite - Gisat-1. This satellite will allow the government to better monitor the country's borders, especially with Pakistan and China, through imaging the sub-continent 3-4 times daily.

The COVID-19 pandemic had delayed the launch of Gisat-1 multiple times this year, but the satellite will finally begin its ascent from Sriharikota spaceport on August 12 at 5:43 am, IANS reported. ISRO's GSLV-F10 rocket will carry the 2,268-kg Gisat-1 into Earth's geo-orbit. The code name of Gisat-1 is EOS-3.

Once Gisat-1 is placed 36,000 km above the surface of the earth in the geostationary orbit, the satellite will be able to constantly monitor areas that are of interest such the country's borders. EO-3 will provide real-time information about a large area, unlike other sensing satellites which are placed in lower orbits and can only cover areas at regular intervals. Gisat-1 will help in the quick monitoring of natural disasters, episodic and short-term events.

Khatwani said, "In the last year and a half, the internet has enabled children to continue with their education, removing the barriers of time and geography. As we encourage children to explore the great knowledge resource available online, we should be cognisant of the threats that come along with the all-pervasive nature of these online mediums." Kimura said, "The COVID-19 pandemic has increased chances for children to face violence whether online or offline. Acknowledging the significant efforts being made to end violence against children, it's important that different stakeholders come together, to increase awareness, change behaviours and perceptions around how, when and where violence against children occurs. "This is critical to promote better understanding the violence and most effective ways to ensure child safety both online and offline," he said.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced the enhancement of collateral free loans to Self Help Groups (SHGs) under DAY-NRLM from Rs10 lakh to Rs20 Lakh.

As per RBI, for loans to SHGs up to Rs10.00 lakh, no collateral and no margin will be charged. No lien should be marked against savings bank account of SHGs and no deposits should be insisted upon while sanctioning loans.



Further, for loans to SHGs above Rs10 lakh and up to Rs20 lakh, no collateral should be charged and no lien should be marked against the savings bank account of SHGs. However, the entire loan (irrespective of the loan outstanding, even if it subsequently goes below Rs10 lakh) would be eligible for coverage under Credit Guarantee Fund for Micro Units (CGFMU).
