1. The statement is correct in its original form and thus, there is no need for rearrangement.

Hence, option D is correct.

2. The beginning fragment talks about a verdict. Thus, the ideal choice here would be the fragment D which describes the verdict more in terms of which institution delivered it-

the Supreme Court **striking down the exclusion of women** from

C and A:

the **exclusion of women from**

the Sabarimala temple has put to rest

A and B:

The Sabarimala temple has **put to rest the question of gender discrimination** The correct sequence is D-C-A-B.

Correct: The path-breaking verdict of the Supreme Court striking down the exclusion of women from the Sabarimala temple has put to rest the question of gender discrimination

Hence, option C is correct.

3. The beginning fragment talks about a phenomenon and thus the next fragment should elaborate on it. Fragment A is ideal in this case.

Connectors:

A and D:

been **employed by social scientists to explain how** events and other developments

D and B:

explain **how events and other developments in one part of the world** can lead

B and C:

in one part of the world **can lead**

to subsequent events in other regions The correct sequence is A-D-B-C.

Correct: The demonstration effect has been employed by social scientists to explain how events and other developments in one part of the world can lead to subsequent events in other regions.

Hence, option B is correct.

4. The beginning fragment talks about a country and its population and thus must ideally continue talking so in the next fragment as well.

Connectors:

C and B:

of over eight million, **Switzerland has an enormous number** of

B and A:

has an **enormous number of people interested in flying** drones

A and D:

people **interested in flying drones**

and developing drone-based applications

The correct sequence is C-B-A-D.

Correct: For a country with a population of over eight million, Switzerland has an enormous number of people interested in flying drones and developing drone-based applications.

5. The beginning fragment starts talking about the price of steel and hence the next fragment should elaborate on the same. The ideal fit here is fragment D.

Connectors:

D and C:

increases, it **signals to businessmen that the supply** of steel is scarce

C and A:

that the supply **of steel is scarce and more of it** needs to be

A and B:

produced to satisfy consumer demand. The correct sequence is D-C-A-B.

Correct: If the price of a commodity like steel increases, it signals to businessmen that the supply of steel is scarce and more of it needs to be produced to satisfy consumer demand.

Hence, option C is correct.

6. **The first fragment of the statement:**

The High-Level Expert Group set up by the Planning Commission (2011)

It should be followed by something that explains the recommendations of the high level committee or there should be something regarding this. Among the given fragments, only C is there that explains the recommendations of the expert group formed by the Planning Commission.

Connectors:

C and B:

C: had recommended that **the**

B: **focus** of healthcare provision in B and A:

B: focus of healthcare provision **in A: the country** should be towards

Only D is left which will complete the statement implying that the focus of healthcare in India should be towards primary healthcare services only.

The complete statement would be: The High-Level Expert Group set up by the Planning Commission (2011) had recommended that the focus of healthcare provision in the country should be towards providing primary healthcare.

This makes the correct sequence of fragments as: **CBAD**.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

7. The fragments of the statement are in order and the sentence is both grammatically and meaningfully correct in its present form. Therefore, no rearrangement is required in this statement.

This makes option D the correct choice among the given options.

8. **The first fragment of the sentence**

Sugar cooperative factories have succeeded

It should be followed by the description regarding the area in which the sugar cooperative factories have succeeded in the country and among the given fragments, only D is there that implies that the cooperatives have been able to manipulate the government administration. This follows the opening fragment of the statement.

Connectors:

D and B:

D: **in manipulating the government administration** B: **and** the condition of

B and C:

B: **and the condition of**

C: **workers** remained more

Only A is left that will complete the statement meaningfully.

The complete sentence would be: Sugar cooperative factories have succeeded in manipulating the

government administration and the condition of workers remained more or less the same. Therefore the correct sequence of fragments is: **DBCA**.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

9. The first fragment of the statement

The poet–singer duo Charul and Vinay,

The next fragment should describe something regarding this duo of poet-singer and among the given fragments, C can give details regarding the duo as the founders of Loknaad and also being instrumental in giving voice to the victims of violence and exploitation.

Connectors:

C and B:

C: the founders of Loknaad give **voice to the** B: **victims of violence**

B and A:

B: victims of **violence**

A: **and exploitation**, and express vision

There is one fragment left to complete the statement to imply the contribution of the poet-singer duo mentioned in the sentence.

The complete statement would be: The poet–singer duo Charul and Vinay, the founders of Loknaad give voice to the victims of violence and exploitation, and express vision of humane society for all.

This makes the proper sequence of the fragments as: **CBAD**.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

10. The first fragment of the statement

The Network of Women in Media in India stands

It should be followed by the contribution of the Network of Women in Media in the country regarding the revelations of the women journalists in the country speaking up against sexual harassment instances against them within the industry itself in the past. Among the given fragments, only A is there that can carry forward this argument and that is why it will follow the first fragment of the statement.

Connectors:

A and C:

A: in absolute solidarity **with all those** C: **who** have bravely spoken up

C and B:

C: who have bravely **spoken up**

B: **about their experiences** of sexual

There is only one fragment left i.e. D to complete the statement as intended.

The complete sentence would be: The Network of Women in Media in India stands in absolute solidarity with all those who have bravely spoken up about their experiences of sexual harassment within the Indian media.

This makes the correct sequence of fragments as: **ACBD**.

This makes option C the correct choice among the given options.

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
