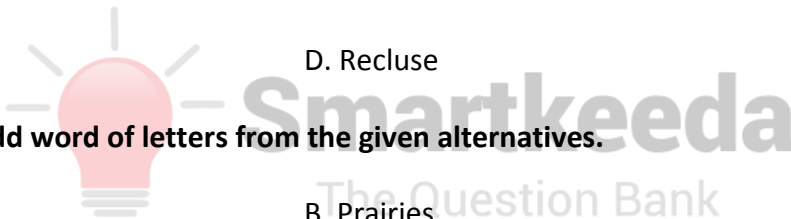

4. Plough → Seeds → Plant → Crop → Harvest

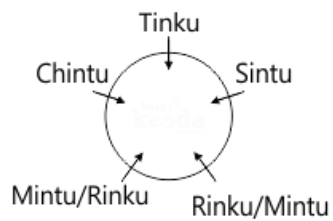

= All classes are institutes \rightarrow implication \rightarrow Some classes are institutes.

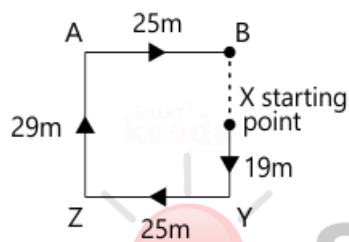
Hence, conclusion I follows.

Therefore, option (D) is correct.

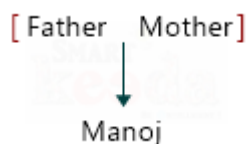
