Explanation:

1. The second one is the characteristic of the first one.

As Dacoits are of evil character, Preachers are enlightened.

Hence option (A) is correct.

2. All others except option (C) represent the diseases caused by virus.

Whereas option C 'Diarrhea' is caused by Bacteria.

Thus option C is the odd one out here.

Hence option (C) is correct.

3. All the given options except option B has first and third letter as vowels.

Whereas in option B- 'OUT', first and second letter is a vowel.

Hence option (B) is correct.

4. The following table shows the reverse position of letters in english alphabet series.

The second one denotes the reverse letters of the first one.(highlighted in green)

Similarly the reverse letters of TV are GE. ((highlighted in red)

Hence option (B) is correct.

Hence, conclusion II follows.

Again, Some register are articles (I) + No article is book (E) = I + E = O = Some register are not book.

Hence conclusion I follows.

Therefore, option (C) is correct.

Post treatment "Recovery" is ensured.

Hence option (B) is correct.

Arushi's sister's mother is Arushi's mother. 7.


Brother of Arushi's mother means Arushi's maternal uncle.

Hence option (C) is the correct answer.

Hence option (D) is correct.

9. From the following explanation it is clear that two persons are standing between B and D.

Hence option (B) is correct.


Reference:

B is standing fourth to the left of A.

D is the immediate neighbour of C who is to the immediate right of E.

Inference:

With the first hint it is clear that A and B respectively are at extreme right and left end of the row. With the second hint positions of E, C and D are shown as below.



The missing term as per the image shown above is 78.

Hence option (C) is correct.
