## Explanations:

1. First one is the race of the second one.

The race of buffalo is called Kambala.
Hence option (C) is correct.
2. All others except option (A) represent pair comprising a vowel and a consonant, but in option $A$ both letters are vowels.

Hence option (A) is correct.

Hence option (C) is correct.
4. Statement: A village is situated beside a national highway. Many vehicles run on the highway.

Conclusions: I. Villagers face sound and air pollution.
II. Villages are connected with the cities.

If villages are situated beside a national highway, we can easily conclude that the villagers have to bear the sound and air pollution generated by the vehicles that run on this highway. Plus, if a highway is beside the villages, it's clear that villages are connected with cities.

Both C 1 and C 2 follow.

Option C is correct.
5. From the below image it is clear that Rina is 13 m south-west from the starting point $X$. Using Pythagoras theorem, we have calculated the distance as 13 m .


Hence option (B) is correct.
6. Aliya's daughter's father means Aliya's husband. Thus Aliya's daughter's father's sister means Aliya's husband's sister.

Uncle of Aliya's husband's sister means Aliya's father-in-law.
Thus Aliya is related to that man as his daughter-in-law.
Hence option (B) is the correct answer.
7. From the following image it is clear that $M$ and $K$ are standing at extreme ends.

Hence option (D) is correct.

The sequence represents the recruitment process of various competitive exams.
