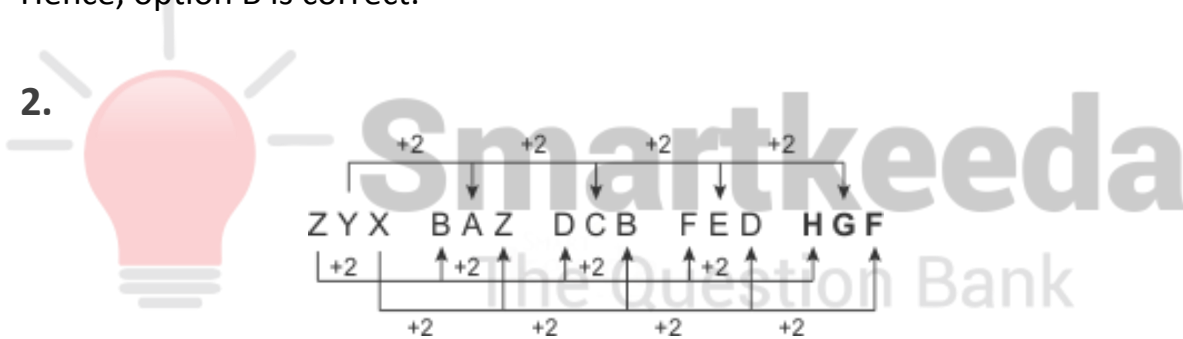
### Explanations:

Hence, option B is correct.

Rush - to go or come with great speed

Go - Walk or move.

Hence, option B is correct.

Each letter is coded as second preceding letter.

$S \xrightarrow{-2} Q$   
 $C \xrightarrow{-2} A$   
 $O \xrightarrow{-2} M$   
 $O \xrightarrow{-2} M$   
 $T \xrightarrow{-2} R$   
 $E \xrightarrow{-2} C$   
 $R \xrightarrow{-2} P$

Hence, option D is correct.

As per the given information, we can infer



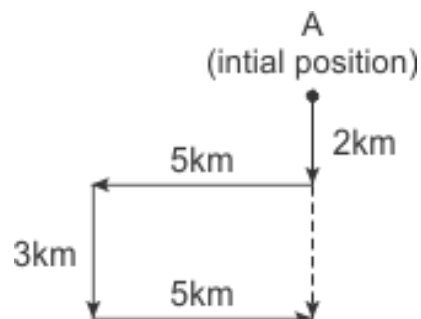

The angle between the two hands of a clock at 3:40 is  $\theta$ .

$$\theta = \frac{11}{2} m - 30 h$$

Here,  $h = 3$  and  $m = 40$

$$\Rightarrow \theta = \frac{11}{2} \times 40 - 30 \times 3$$

$$\Rightarrow \theta = 130^\circ$$

Hence, option C is correct.

8.

Manish's position from left end =  $10 + 17 = 27^{\text{th}}$

Renu's position from left end =  $27 - 8 = 19^{\text{th}}$

Hence, Renu's position from right end =  $45 - 19 + 1 = 27^{\text{th}}$

Hence, option D is correct.

Some books are novels (I).

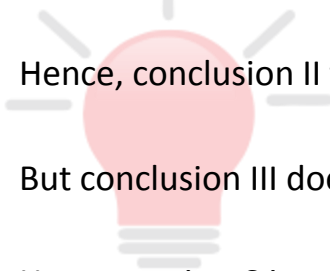
Hence conclusion I follows.
