#### **Explanations :**

**1.** Conclusion I follows since that is what is meant by the statement. Materialism is generally anti value and integrity and hence we can draw the second conclusion.

Hence option C is correct.

**2.** The statement particularly talks about engineering organisations like Tata Motors. The first conclusion is generalising the statement and is hence not valid as a conclusion. The second conclusion follows.

Hence, option B is correct.

**3.** Both conclusions are invalid.

Hence, option D is correct.

**4.** Assumption I is implicit because somewhere down the line, Reliance Fresh is affecting the local vendors. That is why they have been violent. Assumption II is irrelevant because nothing is mentioned regarding the location of the stores.

Hence, option A is correct.

**5.** Green house gases are the root cause of global warming. Hence both A and R are true and R explains A.

Hence option A is correct.

**6.** The Assertion is false because Kerala is not the largest state in India. R is true but it is not related to Assertion.

Hence, option D is correct.

**7.** A is false because a bulb's filament is made of Tungsten and not copper. R is also false because inert gases or nitrogen are filled inside the bulb and there is no vacuum in the bulb.

Hence, option D is correct.

**8.** Only course of action I follows. Government should take care of affected people. It should pay reasonable amount to affected persons. Second course of action does not follow because it is illogical.

Hence, option A is correct.

**9.** No producer is a musician (E)  $\rightarrow$  implication  $\rightarrow$  Some producers are not musicians (O). Hence conclusion I does not follow

No producer is a musician (E) + All musicians are painters (A) =  $E + A = O^* =$  Some painters are not producers (O\*).Hence conclusion II follows.

Some actors are producers (I) + No producer is a musician (E) = I + E = O = Some actors are not musicians (O). Hence conclusion III does not follow. This both conclusion I and III do not follow.

Hence, option D is correct.

**10.** All pens are pencils (A)  $\rightarrow$  implication  $\rightarrow$  Some pens are pencils (I). Hence conclusion I follows.

No paper is an eraser (E)  $\rightarrow$  conversion  $\rightarrow$  No eraser is a paper (E)  $\rightarrow$  implication  $\rightarrow$  Some erasers are not papers (O). Hence conclusion II follows. But the possibility in III does n ot exist. Hence III does not follow.

Hence, option C is correct.
