**3.**

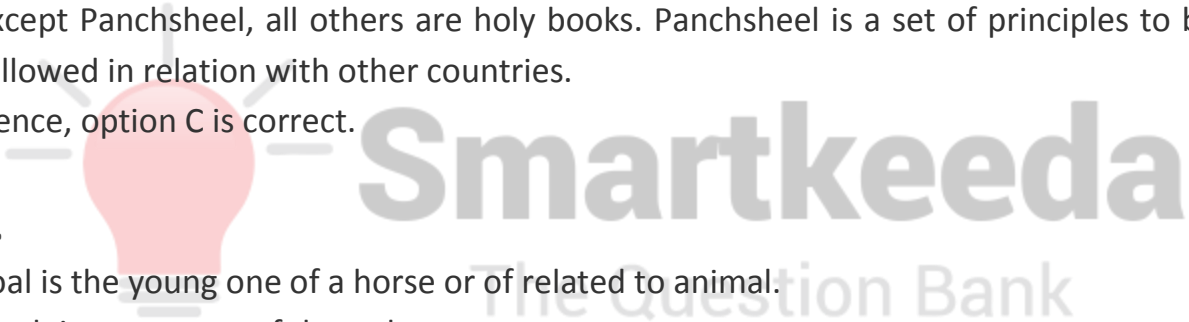
Foal is the young one of a horse or of related to animal.

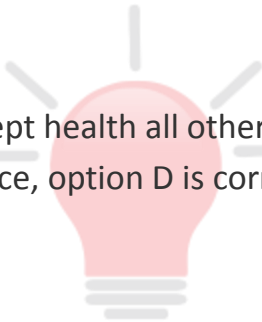
Genius means an exceptionally great mental or creative ability.
