In an artificial language,

"Her spouse was filthy" is written as "P9Y B0W H7K G3M"

"Pooh was never filthy" is written as "H7K A4E G3M C5T"

"Tom never saw Pooh" is written as "S2G L5P C5T A4E"

"Tom and Pooh was spouse" is written as "Q1N L5P G3M A4E P9Y"

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## **Common Explanation (1-5):**

Let us write the second and third lines as follows:

"Pooh never was filthy" is written as "C5T A4E H7K G3M"

"Pooh never Tom saw" is written as "C5T A4E S2G L5P"

we get "Pooh never" = "C5T A4E"

Let us write the left part of the two lines as follows

"was filthy" = "H7K G3M" -----(i)

"Tom saw" = "S2G L5P" -----(ii)

"Pooh never" = "C5T A4E" -----(iii)

From first line, after using (i), code for "Her spouse" = "P9Y B0W"

There is no 'Her' in fourth line, so code for "spouse" = P9Y and "Her" = B0W

Now, we write fourth line without "spouse"
"Tom and Pooh was" is written as "Q1N L5P G3M A4E" -----(iv)

Comparing (iv) with (i), we have code for "was" = G3M, and thus "filthy" = H7K Comparing (iv) with (ii), we have code for "Tom" = L5P and "saw" = S2G Comparing (iv) with (iii), we have code for "Pooh" = A4E and "never" = C5T After this we can easily identify that "and" = Q1N



We write all the codes collectively as follows:

"Pooh" = A4E

"Tom" = L5P

"filthy" = H7K

"spouse" = P9Y

"was" = G3M

"Her" = B0W

"saw" = S2G

"never" = C5T

"and" = Q1N

### **Answers:**

**1.** From common explanation, we have "filthy" = H7K.

Hence, option B is correct.

**2.** From common explanation, we have "and" = Q1N.

Hence, option A is correct.

**3.** We have from common explanation

"never" = C5T

Hence, option D is correct.

**4.** From common explanation, we have

"saw" = S2G

"Pooh" = A4E

"spouse" = P9Y

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Option D has all the required codes.

Hence, option D is correct

**5.** From common explanation, we have codes for

"saw Pooh" = "S2G A4E"

In the given codes, only "He" differs from any word given in the question. Therefore, "He" = U1F.

Hence, option A is correct









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
