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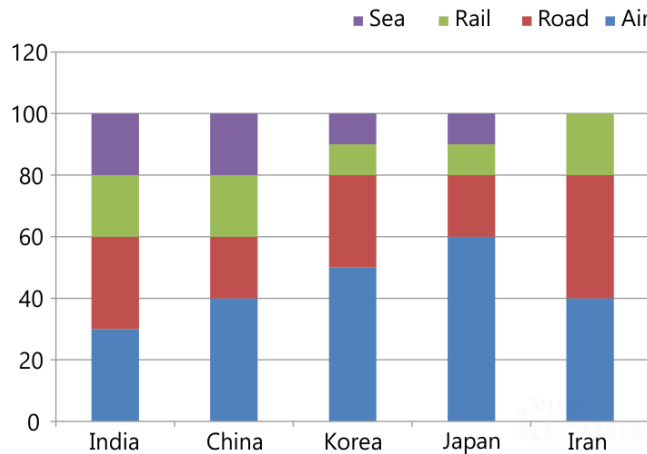

Directions: Study the following graph carefully and answer the questions.

Percentage share of goods transported through Air, Road, Rail and Sea in five countries: India, China, Korea, Japan, Iran.

Given the total weight of goods transported in the 5 countries in a year are.
1086, 3140, 1855, 2360 and 1465 thousand tonnes respectively.



1. Which country transported the maximum quantity of goods by road?

- A. China B. Korea C. Iran D. Japan

2. Which country transported the maximum quantity of goods by Air?

- A. China B. Korea C. Iran D. Japan

3. Which country transported the minimum quantity of goods by Sea?

- A. Iran B. Japan C. India D. Korea

Correct Answers:

1	2	3
C	D	C

Explanations:

1. Transport of goods by road:

$$\text{India} = \frac{1086 \times 30}{100}$$

$$= 325.8 \text{ thousand tonnes}$$

$$\text{Iran} = \frac{1465 \times 50}{100}$$

$$= 732.5 \text{ thousand tonnes}$$

Hence, option C is correct.

2. Transport of goods by air:

$$\text{Japan} = \frac{2360 \times 60}{100}$$

$$= 1416 \text{ thousand tonnes.}$$

Hence, option D is correct.

3. Transport of minimum goods by sea:

$$\text{India} = \frac{1855 \times 10}{100}$$

$$= 185.5 \text{ thousand tonnes}$$

Hence, option C is correct.

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
