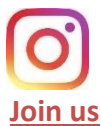

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Answers :

1. Tourists who went to Udaipur by Train = 185

Tourists who went to Delhi by Air = 148

$$\text{Reqd. \%} = 185 \times \frac{100}{148} = 125\%$$

Hence, Option A is the correct.

2. Average number of tourists who went by Air

$$= \frac{174 + 182 + 148 + 148 + 183 + 174}{6}$$

$$= \frac{1009}{6}$$

$$= 168.16$$

Average number of tourists who went by Bus

$$= \frac{172 + 178 + 163 + 142 + 155 + 158}{6}$$

$$= \frac{968}{6}$$

$$= 161.33$$

$$\text{Required difference} = 168.16 - 161.33 = 6.83$$

Hence, Option B is the correct.

3. Tourists who went to Jaipur by car = 180

Tourists who went to Nasik by bus = 155

$$\text{Required ratio} = 36 : 31$$

Hence, Option C is the correct.

4. Tourists who went to Masoori by all vehicles = $174 + 191 + 188 + 172 + 192 = 917$

Tourists who went to Gwalior by all vehicles = $174 + 142 + 163 + 158 + 168 = 805$

Required difference = $917 - 805 = 112$

Hence, Option D is the correct.

5. Tourists who travelled by Bike = $191 + 187 + 181 + 170 + 149 + 142 = 1020$

Reqd. average = $\frac{1020}{6} = 170$

Hence, Option E is the correct.



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
