Table shows the Production, Export and Import of crude oil of 10 countries in 2010 while Table shows the percentage increase in Production, Export and Import of crude oil from 2010 to 2012. Study the tables and answer the questions.

Note 1: consumption = Production + import – export

**Explanations:**

**1.** Total consumption of crude oil =  $(2300 + 1600 + 1900 + 2100 + 900 + 3100 + 5800 + 6000 + 5400 + 5200) + (300 + 400 + 500 + 400 + 1400 + 1300 + 300 + 450 + 550 + 400) - (600 + 500 + 500 + 800 + 300 + 2100 + 4400 + 5100 + 4200 + 4800) = 34300 + 6000 - 23300 = 17000$  million gallons

$$\text{Required average} = \frac{17000}{10} = 1700 \text{ million gallons}$$

Hence, option (B) is correct.

**2.** The table for year 2012 is as under

	Production	Export	Import	Consumption
Afghanistan	2760	690	354	$2760 + 354 - 690 = 2424$
Bangladesh	2000	620	488	$2000 + 488 - 620 = 1868$
Bhutan	2375	625	600	$2375 + 600 - 625 = 2350$
India	2562	960	460	$2562 + 460 - 960 = 2062$
Maldives	1116	375	1708	$1116 + 1708 - 375 = 2449$
Nepal	3565	2352	1495	$3565 + 1495 - 2352 = 2708$
Pakistan	6844	5280	345	$6844 + 345 - 5280 = 1909$
Sri Lanka	6960	5763	526.5	$6960 + 526.5 - 5763 = 1723.5$
Dubai	6048	4704	605	$6048 + 605 - 4704 = 1949$
Abu Dhabi	5928	5280	460	$5928 + 460 - 5280 = 1108$

$$\text{Required average} = \frac{2424 + 1868 + 2350 + 2062 + 2449 + 2708 + 1909 + 1723.5 + 1949 + 1108}{10}$$

$$= \frac{20550.5}{10} = 2055.05 \text{ million gallons}$$

Hence, option (A) is correct.

**3.** The import of the 10 countries together =  $300 + 400 + 500 + 400 + 1400 + 1300 + 300 + 450 + 550 + 400 = 6000$  million gallons

The export of the 10 countries together =  $600 + 500 + 500 + 800 + 300 + 2100 + 4400 + 5100 + 4200 + 4800 = 23300$  million gallons

Required ratio = 233 : 60

Hence, option (C) is correct.

	Percentage increase in consumption of crude oil
Afghanistan	$(2424 - 2000) \times 100/2000 = 21.2\%$
Bangladesh	$(1868 - 1500) \times 100/1500 = 24.53\%$
Bhutan	$(2350 - 1900) \times 100/1900 = 23.68\%$
India	$(2062 - 1700) \times 100/1700 = 21.29\%$
Maldives	$(2449 - 2000) \times 100/2000 = 22.45\%$
Nepal	$(2708 - 2300) \times 100/2300 = 17.74\%$
Pakistan	$(1909 - 1700) \times 100/1700 = 12.29\%$
Sri Lanka	$(1723.5 - 1350) \times 100/1350 = 27.67\%$
Dubai	$(1949 - 1750) \times 100/1750 = 11.37\%$
Abu Dhabi	$(1108 - 800) \times 100/800 = 38.5\%$

Hence, option (E) is correct.
