1. Among the given words, *treat* and *delight* can be used here to make the sentence correct. *Diversion* is not correct here since it implies *distraction from something*.

This makes Option A the correct choice among the given options.

2. According to the given context we can see that various cereals are going to be used by the French in order to make healthy and nutritious food. Among the given words we can use both *nutritive* and *salubrious* to fill the blank since both refer to being healthy and beneficial to health.

This makes Option A the correct choice among the given options.

3. According to the given context it is regarding the fact that all the nutrients and elements sent to the country are first tested for quality and then only they are made to enter the territory of the country without any hassle. Among the given words we can see that both *ingredients* and *elements* can fit in the given blank to make it grammatically and contextually correct.

This makes Option C the correct choice among the given options.

4. According to the given context of the blank, the French people must have got some way in order to create breads using three different millet mixes whereas the same has been developed by a startup in Bengaluru. Among the given words, none of the words will be able to imply the correct meaning of the given context and that is why all of them can be eliminated. *Evolved* means *progressed*, *terminated* means *put an end to something*.

This makes Option E the correct choice among the given options.

5. According to the given context, it is regarding the fact that LEMPA is going to make sure that the millet mixes prepared by the Indian company are going to be used across the country. It will ensure that the products will be circulated throughout the country with the advertisement by the LEMPA. All the given words are similar in meaning and they imply the correct meaning in the given context.

This makes Option E the correct choice among the given options.





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
