The State Government has launched a boat ambulance service at a cost of Rs 5.40 crore to help patients reach hospitals in remote areas cut off by rivers.

The first boat ambulance was launched at Batighar in Kendrapada district on Saturday.

Now, six boats would add to the road ambulanced fleet and would be part of the 108 Ambulance service. Two boat ambulances have been sanctioned for Malkangiri, two for Kendrapada and one each for Koraput and Kalahandi. While one has been launched in Kendrapada. the remaining five boat ambulances would be made operational in a phased manner, said an official release.

The 108 Ambulance service has a fleet of 512 vehicles. Besides, under the 102 Ambulance service, 500 vehicles are deployed across the State.

Patients from the areas cut off by rivers need to wait long for transportation to the nearest hospital. Now, they would use boats to cross water bodies to be picked up by a 108 or 102 Ambulance.

This boat ambulance service includes six boat vehicles and 60 jetties with the walkways. The operational cost for the six ambulances is estimated to be around Rs 90 lakh per annum.
