What: signs MoU with All India Sports Council of the Deaf, to conduct tournaments at all level

When: published on 10th February 2022

The National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) under which the former will conduct competitions at every level for shooters with hearing impairment.

The competitions will be held at district, state, zonal and national level and facilities provided to them will be at par with able-bodied shooters.

What: completes acquisition of 40% stake in Sterling & Wilson Solar

When: published on 11th February 2022

Reliance Industries has completed the planned acquisition of a 40% equity stake in Sterling and Wilson Renewable Energy (SWREL).

RIL's subsidiary Reliance New Energy (RNEL) acquired 10.37% of SWERL on Wednesday at a price of 375 per share amounting to 737.5 crore from Shapoorji Pallonji and Company Pvt Ltd and Khurshed Daruvala, both promoters of SWREL, as per the stock exchange filing. This was the last tranche of the transaction, culminating in a 40% stake for RIL in SWERL.

What: increases FPI limit in debt market to Rs 2.5 lakh crore

When: published on 11th February 2022

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has increased the limit for foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) to invest in the local debt market from Rs 1 lakh crore to Rs 2.5 lakh crore under the Voluntary Retention Route (VRR) with effect from April 1.

According to RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das, VRR will be revised on April 1 to provide a separate channel, free from macroprudential controls, for FPI investment in government and corporate debt securities.

Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari, who had been appointed as the Acting Chief Justice of the Madras High Court recently, has been made the Chief Justice of the High Court.

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A communication to this effect was signed by the President of India and issued.

Justice M N Bhandari was transferred to the Madras High Court in November last year and he assumed office as the ACJ on November 22.

India's prolific wicketkeeper-batter Rishabh Pant won top 'Test batting' prize for his 89 not out, which shattered Australia's unbeaten record at Gabba and helped India win the Border Gavaskar Trophy last year while New Zealand skipper Kane Williamson was adjudged 'Captain of the Year' at the 15th Annual ESPNcricinfo awards.

The Test bowling award went to Kyle Jamieson for his 5 for 31, which helped New Zealand become the first World Test champions.

Pant steered India to an unlikely victory in the dying moments of play in the last Test, taking them to a 2-1 series win that few would have predicted when India went into the match with a third-string side in the wake of numerous injuries to their first-choice players.

What: extends term-liquidity facility to emergency health services till June 30, 2022

When: published on 10th February 2022

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Thursday proposed to extend the term-liquidity facility of Rs 50,000 crore offered to emergency health services by three months till June 30, 2022. Last year in May, RBI had announced an on-tap liquidity window of Rs 50,000 crore, at the repo rate with tenors of up to three years, to boost provision of immediate liquidity for ramping up Covid-19-related healthcare infrastructure and services in the country.

Banks were incentivised for quick delivery of credit under the scheme through extension of priority-sector classification to such lending up to March 31, 2022.

"In view of the response to the scheme, it is now proposed to extend this window up to June 30, 2022 from March 31, 2022 as announced earlier," RBI said in the statement on Development and Regulatory Policies on Thursday.

It also aims to raise awareness about the contribution of women and girls in the field of science and technology.

The present cap of Rs 10,000 will be increased to Rs 1 lakh per voucher and such vouchers will be allowed to be used more than once, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said while announcing the latest monetary policy meeting outcome.

Who: UK scientists

What: set new record for generating energy from nuclear fusion with reaction '10 times hotter than the sun'

When: published on 9th February 2022

Scientists in the UK have set a new record for generating energy from nuclear fusion, the same process that powers our sun seen as a potential future source of near limitless power.

The Joint European Torus, or JET, an experimental fusion machine near Abingdon in Oxfordshire, generated around 59 megajoules, or 11 Megawatts of energy - enough to power around 10,000 homes - in a five second burst.

The experiment still consumed more energy to create the fusion reaction than the energy released by it, but a sustained fusion event of this kind is a major advance.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has asserted that the government's inflation management is robust and the inflation rate stands at 6.2 percent despite the challenges posed by the unprecedented Covid-19 pandemic. She countered opposition's allegations over the inflation while replying to discussion on the Union Budget 2022-23 in the Rajya Sabha today.

Referring to the global financial crisis in 2008-09, she said, the Indian economy witnessed a contraction of 2.12 lakh crore rupees during that time, whereas the country witnessed contraction of 9.57 lakh crore rupees during the Covid-19 pandemic.

What: ranks 46th in the Democracy Index for 2021 out of 165 nations

When: published on 10th February 2022

India has ranked in 46 out of 167 countries surveyed in the latest iteration of the Economist Intelligence Unit's (EIU) 'Democracy Index 2021', which pertains to the year 2021, scoring 6.91 out of a possible 10. This is an improvement of seven places and 0.3 points when compared to its score last year. In fact, is among the top 10 countries with respect to their score improvement.

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With this score, India maintains its classification as a 'flawed democracy'.

National Deworming Day (NDD) is observed annually on 10 February. The day was started as an initiative under the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare to make every child between the ages of one and 19 years across the country free from intestinal worms, as per a statement on the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare's website. Furthermore, these intestinal worms are also referred to as Soil-Transmitted Helminths (STH).

According to the World Health Organisation (WHO), there are about 241 million children in India who are at risk of intestinal worms. And more than 836 million children worldwide are at risk of this parasitic worm infection.

Ratan N Tata who was a special invitee to this meeting expressed his satisfaction on the progress and performance of the Tata group under the leadership of Chandrasekaran. "He recommended his term be renewed for a further five-year period," Tata Sons said.
