On completion of the transaction, BoB will hold a 65% stake in IndiaFirst Life, Union Bank will hold 9% and Carmel Point Investments India will have the remaining 26% stake. IndiaFirst Life Insurance will continue to have long-term agency distribution agreement with both Bank of Baroda and Union Bank after stake sale, according to an exchange filing.

Israel becomes the first-ever country to allow drones in civilian airspace. Referring to this, the Israel's Ministry of Transport and Road Safety recently announced the country's first certification for unmanned aircraft vehicles (UAVs) to operate in civilian airspace.

As per the reports, the certification was issued to the Hermes Starliner unmanned system by the Israeli Civil Aviation Authority (CAA), and was manufactured and developed by Elbit Systems, an Israeli defense electronics company.

Israeli Transport and Road Safety Minister Merav Michaeli stated, "I am proud that Israel becomes the first country which allows UAVs to operate for the benefit of agriculture, environment, fight against crime, the people and the economy."

The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and the Indian Navy have seized over 760 kg narcotics, including hashish, methamphetamine and heroin, worth about Rs 2,000 crore in the international market, from the high seas off Gujarat coast, officials said on Saturday.

The joint operation was carried out in the Arabian Sea off the Gujarat coast, leading to the seizure of these drugs, an NCB official said.

"In a joint operation carefully planned by the NCB and the Indian Navy in the high seas, NCB officials have successfully seized around 529 kg of very high quality of hashish, 234 kg of finest quality of crystal methamphetamine and some quantity of heroin," the anti-drug agency said in a release. Who: 'Operation Parivartan': 2 Lakh Kilograms Processed Cannabis

What: Seized by Police in Andhra Pradesh

When: published on 11th February 2022

The Andhra Pradesh Police has initiated 'Operation Parivartan', a special operation undertaken to eliminate the cultivation of cannabis. Such an initiative was never been taken up before and it helps the state to fight against the drugs menace. This operation was led by the Andhra Pradesh Police with the Special Enforcement Bureau (SEB) in Visakhapatnam.

Around 2 lakh kilograms of processed cannabis was seized while it was being shipped out post-harvest. The seized cannabis will be destroyed in Visakhapatnam on Saturday.

From November 2021 to February 2022, the Andhra Pradesh Police have deforested cannabis plants spread across 8,500 acres, before the harvest season.

India signed an MoU with the UN World Food Programme for distribution of 50,000 MT of wheat that it will send to Afghanistan via the land border with Pakistan. While calling for unhindered access to humanitarian aid for Afghanistan, India had also maintained that it was important to involve UN for aid distribution to ensure it was non-discriminatory.

India had proposed in October last year that Pakistan allow India to ship 50,000 MT of wheat through the land route. After all approvals obtained from Pakistan, India will finally start dispatching the grain to Afghanistan "very soon". Elections in Punjab and several logistical challenges involving use of thousands of trucks delayed the exercise.

"The Government under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved continuation of the umbrella scheme of Modernisation of Police Forces (MPF). The approval for the period 2021-22 to 2025-26, moves forward the initiative of the Union Home Minister Amit Shah to modernise and improve the functioning of Police Forces of States and Union Territories. This scheme comprises all relevant sub-schemes that contribute to modernization and improvement with a total Central financial outlay of Rs.26,275 crore," said the MHA in a statement.

When: published on 11th February 2022

India was ranked third in the world for LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) green buildings in 2021 with a total of 146 certified buildings and spaces, representing nearly 2.8 million gross area square meters (GSM) in the US Green Building (USGBC) annual list.

China topped the list with more than 14 million GSM, and Canada certified more than 3.2 million GSM.

LEED is the most widely used green building rating system in the world.

In India, LEED is administered by Green Business Certification Inc. (GBCI), which has been working towards accelerating the adoption of green buildings across the country.

Who: Odisha's Malkangiri

What: is NITI Aayog's 'most improved district'

When: published on 11th February 2022

Malkangiri has topped NITI Aayog's list of 'Most Improved Aspirational Districts in Agriculture and Water Resources Sector' for the month of December, 2021. Malkangiri is followed by Chhatarpur in Madhya Pradesh, Baramulla in J&K, Ramgarh in Jharkhand and Begusarai in Bihar, as per NITI Aayog's Delta Rankings for December, 2021, the district administration stated on its Twitter handle.

The ranking is based on incremental progress made across 49 key performance indicators (KPIs) under five broad socio-economic themes - health and nutrition, education, agriculture and water resources, financial inclusion and skill development and infrastructure. The Aspirational District programme aims to effectively transform 112 most under-developed districts across the country. The broad contours of the programme are 'convergence' (of Central and State schemes), 'collaboration' (of Central, State level 'Prabhari' officers and district collectors), and 'competition' among districts through monthly Delta ranking; all driven by a mass movement.

What: emerged as the second largest buyer of Gold When: published on 8th February 2022

When it comes to gold buying, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) emerged as the second largest buyer of yellow metal among the world's Central Banks in 2021. The largest buyer, the Central Bank of Thailand, bought 90 metric tonnes of gold while RBI bought 77.5 metric tonnes taking its total gold reserve to 754.1 tonnes at the end of December 2021. India's official gold reserves is ninth largest in the world, says Goldhub, the official website of World Gold Council that maintains all the data regarding precious metal (see table). The charm of the yellow metal has captivated RBI, which has been on a gold buying spree since 2009. The purchase in last calendar year is the second highest annual level of buying in the new millennium. In 2009, India bought 200 tonnes of gold from the International Monetary Fund (IMF). Hence, the correct answer is option A. (Read more)
