Decision is incorrect as it was not the decision of the government but a set of external factors which led to the drop in oil prices.

Initiation means start/beginning and is incorrect.

Result fits in well contextually and grammatically.

Hence, option D is correct.

2.

Logically, creditors having a majority share would take decisions pertaining to a company. Thus, minority and auxiliary (minor) can be eliminated.

Humble and inconspicuous are both absurd and do not fit in.

Only dominant which means majority/main/primary fits in.

Abuse can be eliminated as it does not fit in.

Hence, option A is correct.

Time is grammatically incorrect as the correct phrase would be racing against time.

World and early are irrelevant and can be eliminated easily.

Clock fits in well. It is grammatically correct and conveys the meaning well.

Hence, option C is correct.

Involved is incorrect as it does not fit with into.

Dealing and manufacturing also do not convey the correct meaning.

Only plugged fits in well. Plugged into means involved in.

Hence, option A is correct.

7.

Deaths have actually decreased as per the statement and option A is incorrect.

Effect means result/ consequence and is incorrect here.

Impact is incorrect in terms of grammar.

Only Affected fits in well.

Hence, option C is correct.
