Option C: Rectify means to correct and is incorrect here in terms of context.

Option E: *Altercation* means *a fight/argument* and is meaningless here.

Option D: Both words fit in perfectly.

Hence, option D is correct.

6. The US President would impose tariffs if India does not *reduce duties* on American exports. This eliminates Option C.

Reduction of option D is grammatically incorrect. This also eliminates option E.

Option A is absurd and meaningless.

Only option B fits in well.

Hence, option B is correct.

7. A trade war would lead to a *reduction* in world trade. This eliminates options A and B.

Option D is incorrect due to use of *narrow* which does not fit in grammatically as the second blank needs a *noun* while *narrow* is an *adjective*.

For does not fit in blank I in option C and is incorrect.

Option E is correct as both words fit in perfectly.

Hence, option E is correct.

8. Option A: The use of *an* before the blank necessitates the use of a *vowel* and hence *desired* does not fit in I. Also, the use of *roughly* before in the statement conveys the figure is *approximate* and not *exact*.

Option B: The use of *an* before the blank necessitates the use of a *vowel* and hence *desired* does not fit in I.

Option D: Bold does not fit in I due to use of an.

Option E: *Close* does not fit in II.

Option C: Both words fit in perfectly well.

Hence, option C is correct.

9. Option A: Both words fit in logically and grammatically.

Option B: Both words fit in logically and grammatically.
