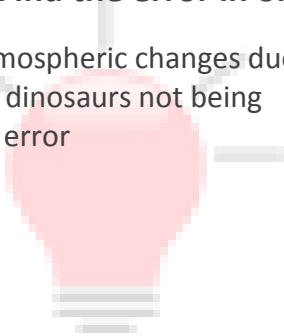

**Explanations :**

- 1.** The fragment C of the sentence is erroneous as "for the Darfur region" is to be replaced with "to the Darfur region", since the Darfur region is a geographical location.

The correct sentence would be, "The United Nations warns that it has become very difficult to send food aid to the Darfur region of Sudan because of repeated truck hijacks."

Option C is hence the correct answer..

- 2.** The fragment C of the sentence is incorrect since "damage" should be replaced by "damages". As a noun, "damage" refers to physical harm or injury. "Damages" refers to the cost or money equivalent estimated for the harm caused.

The correct sentence would be, "Hurricane "Katrina" that devastated the city of New Orleans, caused damages estimated in the billions of dollars."

Option C is hence the correct answer.

- 3.** The sentence is absolutely correct and has no error in it.

Option E is hence the correct answer.

- 4.** The word 'regarded' modifies both 'valuable in itself' and 'service to the nation'. Therefore, regarded should be placed before 'not only' and not after or in between.

The correct sentence would be, "Creativity, in any field, is regarded not only as valuable in itself, but also as a service to the nation."

Option B is hence the correct answer.

- 5.** The phrase in fragment A "commit themselves to" should be followed by a gerund in fragment B. Therefore, fragment B should read " ... to financing a massive ..."

The correct sentence would be, "The rich countries should commit themselves to financing a massive program of technology and to a program of technology transfer to developing countries."

Option B is hence the correct answer.

**6.** "Hand down" means 'to pass something on to someone' is the correct idiom to be used in part A of the sentence. "Handling down" is an incorrect expression in the context of the sentence.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

**7.** The verb used must agree to the subject "changes" (plural) in number. Therefore, the verb 'have' should be used instead of 'has' (singular).

Option C is hence the correct answer.

**8.** There is absolutely no error in the given sentence.

Option E is hence the correct answer.

**9.** In part D of the sentence, the word "fostering" meaning 'encourage the development of' does not require a preposition "to" after it. Hence, the preposition "to" is redundant in part D.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

**10.** "Sustain" is a transitive verb that requires an object; it is grammatically and contextually incorrect in this sentence. A more appropriate verb would be 'survive'.

Option D is hence the correct answer.



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
