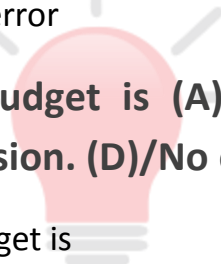

Explanations:

1.

Replace 'somewhat' with 'some'.

Hence, option C is correct.

2.

Use 'take on' meaning to decide to do something or undertake a responsibility.

Hence, option C is correct.

3.

'Advice' means counsel and is not used in plural. When 'advice' is to be used in plural, use it as 'pieces of advice' to convey plural meaning instead of 'advices'. 'Advices' means information.

Hence, option C is correct.

4.

Change 'pain' to 'pains' to corrects the error in diction. Because 'pain' means 'suffering' while 'pains' means 'careful efforts'.

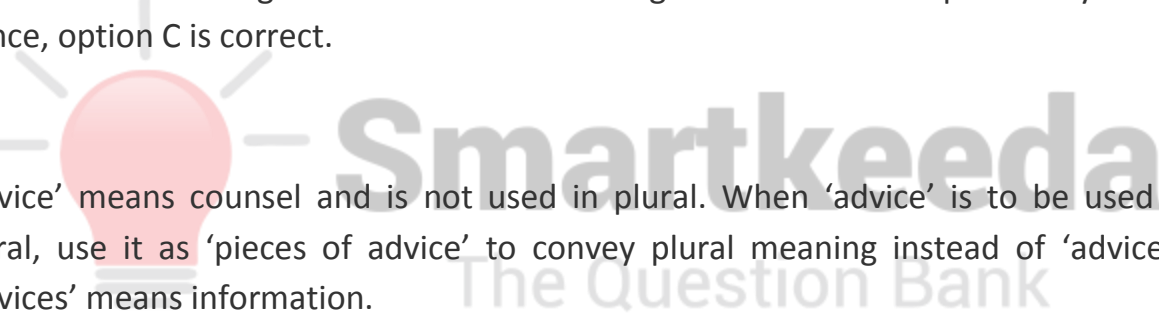
Hence, option C is correct.

5.

Delete 'is' after 'and' as 'and unfriendly'. Avoid the repetition of the same verb 'is' after coordinating conjunction 'and' for the same subject.

Hence, option C is correct..

6.



Change 'have ruined' to 'has ruined' to correct the error of subject verb agreement. Because the subject 'herd' is a collective noun and is always followed by a singular verb.

Hence, option C is correct.

7.

Change 'her manner is' to 'her manners are' to correct the usages. Because when 'manner' is used for behavior, it is used in plural but in the sense of method or way, it is used both in singular and plural.

Hence, option C is correct.

8.

Use definite article 'the' before 'house' because 'house' in the sentence refers to a particular house (Lok Sabha).

Hence, option D is correct.

9.

Use definite article 'the' before 'sea'.

Hence, option B is correct.

10.

Change 'from' to 'out of' to correct the expression.

Hence, option D is correct.
