Explanations:

1.

In part B, the relative pronoun 'who' must be replaced with 'which' as 'law' is not a living being.

The correction formation will be- 'The government has introduced a new law which forces farmers to sell their produce only to licensed dealers.'

Hence, option B is correct.

2.

In part D, the word 'challenge' must be in plural form as the adjective 'various' before it, refers to 'of different kinds'.

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Hence, option D is correct.

3.

In part C, 'sells' must be replaced with 'selling' to make it a grammatically correct sentence.

Hence, option C is correct.

4.

Under the context, bank is a singular non-living entity for which the pronoun 'its' must be used in possessive case instead of 'their' in part D.

So the correct formation will be- 'The only option for the bank is to modernize its operations at all its branches.'

Hence, option D is correct.

5.

In part A, there are two negatives- 'lack' and 'no funds' which cannot go together. The correct formation will be - 'The lack of funds has resulted in several delays in launching our new product in India.

Hence, option A is correct.

6.

In part C, the phrase 'at less' must be replaced with the idiom 'at least', which means 'not less than', to make it a grammatically correct sentence. Hence, option C is correct.

7.

In part B, the noun 'detail' must be replaced with the adjective 'detailed' to make it a grammatically correct sentence.

Hence, option B is correct. Smartkeeda

8.

In part B, 'underwent' must be replaced with 'undergone' (past participle of undergo) as the sentence is in Present Perfect Tense which is formed with a present tense form of 'to have' plus the past participle of the verb. Hence, optiion B is correct.

9.

To make the sentence a grammatically correct one, in part A, the preposition 'among' must be replaced with 'between', which is used while talking about a choice that involves two people, groups, or things.

Hence, option A is correct.

10.

In part D, 'to success' must be replaced with 'to succeed' as part D has to be in the infinitive form (to + verb) in the context of the sentence.

Hence, option D is correct
