Explanations:

1. Fragment A is erroneous.

Usage of the word 'excepts' is incorrect contextually and it should be replaced with 'aspects' in order to make the sentence correct.

Except (preposition): not including

Ex: All were invited to the party except Ram.

Aspect (noun): a particular part or feature of something.

Ex: We need to evaluate the situation considering all aspects.

Fragment D is erroneous too.

The correct phrasal verb to be used is 'engaged in' and not 'engaged through'. Here, the preposition 'through' must be replaced with 'in' to make the sentence grammatically correct.

Engage in (Phrasal Verb): to take part in a particular activity.

Ex: He is engaged in many anti social activities.

Correct Sentence:

While reflecting on the **aspects** that a future social contract might follow, the opinions of the younger generation must be integrated, as they are the ones who will be asked to live with the same generation that is now so engaged **in** the vanguard of the fight against racism.

Option A is hence the correct answer.



2. Fragment B is erroneous.

Usage of noun 'representation' before 'democracy' is incorrect; it should be replaced with adjective 'representational' which will qualify noun 'democracy' in order to make the sentence correct.

Fragment D is erroneous too.

Here, 'latter' should be replaced with 'later' in order to make the sentence correct.

Later : Later refers to something happening in the future.

Ex: I shall call you later on.

Latter: Latter refers to the second of two things mentioned in the previous sentence or phrase.

Ex: Between Ram and his sister, the latter is good at mathematics.

Correct Sentence:

In some respects, the French Revolution did not succeed but the ideas of **representational** democracy and basic property rights took hold, and it sowed the seeds of the **later** revolutions of 1830 and 1848.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

3. Fragment A is erroneous.

'Ethnicity' should be replaced with 'ethnicities' in order to make the sentence correct. As the use of 'different' is mentioned, the following noun should be plural.

Fragment B is erroneous too.

Here, the preposition 'on' must be replaced by 'at' to make the sentence grammatically correct.

Land on (Phrasal Verb): to criticize someone severely

He really landed on me for being late.

Whereas 'land at' represents a particular place.

Ex: His plane landed at the city ground.

Correct Sentence:

Journalists, bloggers of different **ethnicities** are kept tracked once they land **at** the Chinese airport, asked to delete footage of cameras and even in some cases they assign some noob pedestrian to follow them.

Option A is hence the correct answer.

4. Fragment B is erroneous.

The helping verb 'has' should be followed by 'been' as the segment is in passive voice.

Fragment D is erroneous too.

'Like' should be replaced with adverb 'likely' in order to make the sentence grammatically sound, as we need an adverb in the segment for modification.

Correct Sentence:

A bill to reduce the number of foreign workers in Kuwait has **been** partially approved and Indians, who form the largest expat community, are **likely** to be the worst affected.

Option B is hence the correct answer.



5. Fragment C is erroneous.

Idiom 'jew dropping' should be replaced with 'jaw dropping' in order to make the sentence contextually correct.

Jaw Dropping: very surprising or shocking.

Ex: The research displayed some jaw dropping results.

Fragment D is erroneous too.

Usage of verb 'shrink' is incorrect and should be replaced with adjective 'shrinking' in order to make the sentence correct. 'Population' which is the noun should be qualified by an adjective.

Correct Sentence:

The world is ill-prepared for the global crash in children being born which is set to have a **jaw-dropping** impact on societies due to the falling fertility rates resulting in **shrinking** population.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

6. Fragment C is erroneous.

Reason: Usage of 'are' in the fragment is grammatically incorrect. 'the pressure' mentioned in fragment B is singular and therefore the verb should be singular too. Thus, 'are' should be replaced with 'is'.

Correct Sentence:

China is experiencing a fall in domestic consumption, investment and exports and the pressure on employment **is** rising significantly, while financial risks are mounting.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

7. Fragment C is erroneous.

Reason: 'when' should be replaced with 'than' .The correct form of conjunctival pair to be used is 'no sooner....than' and not 'no sooner.....when'.

No sooner....than: used to convey that the mentioned second event happens immediately after the first.

Ex. No sooner had the alarm stopped than he called the authorities.

Correct Sentence:

No sooner had RAW got to know that Pakistan had placed an order for Arctic weather gear from a London company **than** Operation Meghdoot was launched.

Option C is hence the correct answer.

8. Fragment D is erroneous.

Reason: Usage of 'rapid' is grammatically incorrect as we need an adverb in the fragment not an adjective. Thus, 'redirect' verb should be modified by the adverb 'rapidly' instead of the adjective 'rapid'.

Rapidly (adverb): very quickly; at a great rate.

Ex. Corona cases are increasing rapidly.

Correct Sentence:

Except in theoretical endeavors, good laboratories require good funding as a result when there is a hint of something important, wealthy laboratories can redirect their resources **rapidly**.

Option D is hence the correct answer.

9. Fragment B is erroneous.

Reason: Usage of 'informations' is incorrect. 'Information' which is noun is uncountable and cannot be used as a plural.

Correct Sentence:

When a smart pill is swallowed, it gets activated in the gut and the sensors provide **information** about the health parameters of the patient leading to more informed healthcare decisions and optimized therapies.

Option B is hence the correct answer.

10. Fragment B is erroneous.

Reason: The use of 'with' is grammatically incorrect as the correct form of phrasal verb to be used is 'related to'. Thus, 'to' should be used instead of 'with'.

Correct Sentence:

Spiritual practices are regular, disciplined activities related **to** spiritual development and enable people to progress along a path towards whatever they see as the ultimate goal of human life.

Option B is hence the correct answer.
