Explanation:

1. Coringa Wildlife Sanctuary is situated in the southern state of Andhra Pradesh. It is the second largest mangrove stretch of the country with around 24 kinds of mangroves, 120 kinds of birds and animals etc. This place is also the home to various endangered species such as the long billed venture.

Hence, option B is correct.

2. Sophia Cup, Narang Cup, Divan Cup and Amrit Diwan Cup are tournaments arranged for badminton. Murugappa Gold Cup is a tournament associated with hockey. Some other tournaments associated with hockey are Nehru Trophy, Sindhi Gold Cup, Wellington Cup etc.

Hence, option E is correct.

4. Tatipudi Reservoir Project is built on Gosthani river in Vizag, Andhra Pradesh and it works as the water supply project to the city of Vizag. This dam was built in 1963-1968. It is also aimed at increasing the total irrigation area of the city.

Hence, option C is correct.

5. The present governor of Gujarat is Acharya Dev Vrat whereas Mridula Sinha used to serve as the governor of Goa till 2019. Satyadev Narayan Arya is the present governor of Haryana and Fagu Chauhan is the present governor of Bihar. The present governor of Goa is Satya Pal Mallik.

Hence, option A is correct.

6. Dhuvaran Thermal Power Plant is located in Anand District, Gujarat. This was however decommissioned in the year 2010. It was owned by Gujarat State Electricity Board and it used to be the first ever thermal power plant of the state-owned entity in Gujarat.

Hence, option B is correct.

7. Narora Nuclear Power Plant is situated in Uttar Pradesh whereas Kakrapar Nuclear Power Plant is situated in Gujarat. Tarapur Nuclear Power Plant is located in Maharashtra and Kalapakkam Nuclear Power Plant is there in Tamil Nadu.

Hence, option D is correct.

8. Mouling National Park is situated in Arunachal Pradesh in the Upper Slang district and it also forms some part of West Slang and East Slang districts. This is the second national park in Arunachal Pradesh after Namdapha National Park in 1972. It is the part of the Dihang-Dibang biosphere reserve in the state.

Hence, option B is correct.

9. Swami Vivekananda Airport is situated in Chhattisgarh. It is the primary airport of the state situated in Raipur. It is the 26th busiest airport in India in terms of passenger traffic and 29th busiest airport of the country by way of aircraft movement. The airport, formerly known as Raipur Airport, has been renamed in 2012 after the great monk Swami Vivekananda.

Hence, option A is correct.

10. BRICS is the group of the developing and emerging nations that came into existence in 2010 (Before that it was BRIC) with the introduction of South Africa that year. The main objective is to present the case of the emerging nations in front of the world. The headquarters of BRICS are based in Shanghai, China.

Hence, option A is correct.

11. United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) is aimed at providing developmental and humanitarian aid to the children around the world. This was established in 1946 by the UN General Assembly in order to create a platform for the children around the world. This is based in New York, USA. The initial objective was to provide relief to children affected by the World War II.

Hence, option C is correct.

12. Mathura, Etawah and Auriya are located on the bank of Yamuna River and they are all in Uttar Pradesh. Fatehgarh is also located in Uttar Pradesh and it is situated on the bank of the river Ganges.

Hence, option D is correct.

13. Mistura Food Festival is observed to celebrate the culture and agriculture of Peru. It is generally celebrated in September and the farmers come from various parts of the country to showcase their products in the exhibition. The visitors can try various famous Peruvian dishes while participating in this festival.

Hence, option D is correct.

14. Red Revolution is associated with meat and tomato whereas Yellow Revolution is associated with oil seeds. Round Revolution is known to be associated with potato production.

Hence, option D is correct.

15. Siegfried Line is located between Germany and France. Hindenburg Line is situated between Germany and Poland. Maginot Line is located between France and Germany and actually Siegfried Line was located opposite the French Maginot Line.

Hence, option B is correct.

16. Bengaluru is known as the Electronic City of India / Silicon Valley of India whereas Bhagalpur is known as Silk City of India. Ahmedabad is known as Boston of India / Manchester of India. Bhopal is known as the City of Lakes and Bhubaneswar is the Temple City of India.

20. Rose Bowl Cricket Stadium is known as Hampshire Bowl for the ICC Cricket World Cup 2019. This is the home ground for Hampshire Country Cricket Club in England. However it is an international stadium in UK hosting the ODI and test matches for the international sides.

Hence, option E is correct.

21. Ojapali, Bihu and Ankia Nat are dance forms prevalent in Assam whereas Popir is a popular folk dance form prevalent in Arunachal Pradesh. Chalo and aji lamu also are famous folk dance forms of Arunachal Pradesh.

Hence, option D is correct.

22. The International Cancer Day is celebrated every year on February 4 in order to create awareness regarding cancer. The main objective of the day is to create mass awareness regarding the prevention, detection and treatment of cancer as a disease. The day is celebrated by the initiative of Union for International Cancer Control and was celebrated for the first time in 2008.

Hence, option C is correct.

23. The Kalidas Samman is presented every year by the Government of Madhya Pradesh for excellence in the areas of classical music, classical dance and arts. It is named after the renowned poet of India, Kalidas. The award was first constituted in 1980 but then it used to be given every alternate year whereas from 1986-87 onwards it is given in one of the four areas – classical music, classical dance, theatre and plastic arts.

Hence, option E is correct.

24. Sri Guru Ram Dass Jee International Airport named after Guru Ram Das Ji, the fourth Sikh Guru and the founder of Amritsar city, is an international airport about 11 kilometres northwest of the city of Amritsar, Punjab, India.

Hence, the correct answer is option D.

25. National Productivity Council (NPC) is a mission oriented apex organization to promote the cause of productivity in all sectors of the Indian economy, established as autonomous, multipartite, non-profit organization by the Ministry of Industry, Govt. of India in 1958. NPC is a constituent of the Tokyo-based Asian Productivity Organization (APO), an Inter Governmental Body, of which the Government of India is a founder member.

Option C is hence the correct answer.



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
