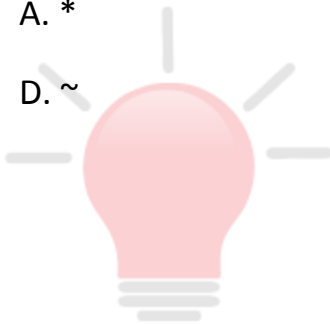

### Explanations:

1.

Best fit allocates the smallest hole that is big enough. This strategy produces the smallest leftover hole. The best fit deals with allocating the smallest free partition which meets the requirement of the requesting process. This algorithm first searches the entire list of free partitions and considers the smallest hole that is adequate. It then tries to find a hole which is close to actual process size needed.

In the first fit approach is to allocate the first free partition or hole large enough which can accommodate the process. It finishes after finding the first suitable free partition.

In worst fit approach is to locate largest available free portion so that the portion left will be big enough to be useful. It is the reverse of best fit.

Hence, option B is correct.

2.

A folder contains a set of files. Folder name is the name assigned to the specific folder. It is possible to name the folder using characters, numbers, and special characters. But there are certain limitations while using this special character as a folder name. For example, '/', '\', '\*', '?', '<', '>' are some special characters that cannot be used as a folder name.

Hence, option B is correct.

**3.**

The grep command is used to search for generalized regular expressions occurring in UNIX files. For example, grep '05' phone.list searches for the number 05 in the given file.

Hence, option A is correct.

**4.**

A Horn clause is a clause (a disjunction of literals) with at most one positive, i.e. unnegated, literal. Conversely, a disjunction of literals with at most one negated literal is called a dual-Horn clause.

A Horn clause with exactly one positive literal is a definite clause; a definite clause with no negative literals is sometimes called a fact; and a Horn clause without a positive literal is sometimes called a goal clause (note that the empty clause consisting of no literals is a goal clause).

$p \rightarrow \emptyset q$  is not a horn clause.

Hence, option D is correct.

**5.**

Given below are the various versions of Android.

Hence, Android 6 – 6.0.1 → Marshmallow is the correct matching pair with respect to android OS.

Hence, option A is correct.

We tried to delete a record, but parts of it were left undeleted because of unawareness, the data is also saved somewhere this anomaly is deletion anomaly, although these anomalies are removed thereafter but with special operations.

An update anomaly is a data inconsistency that results from data redundancy and a partial update.

A Delete Anomaly exists when certain attributes are lost because of the deletion of other attributes.

An Insert Anomaly occurs when certain attributes cannot be inserted into the database without the presence of other attributes.

Hence, option B is correct.

The condition for trivial functional dependency is  $FD (X \rightarrow Y)$  holds, where  $Y$  is a subset of  $X$ , it always holds. If  $FD (X \rightarrow Y)$  holds, where  $Y$  is not a subset of  $X$ , then it is said to be non-trivial functional dependency.

Hence, option A is correct.

**9.**

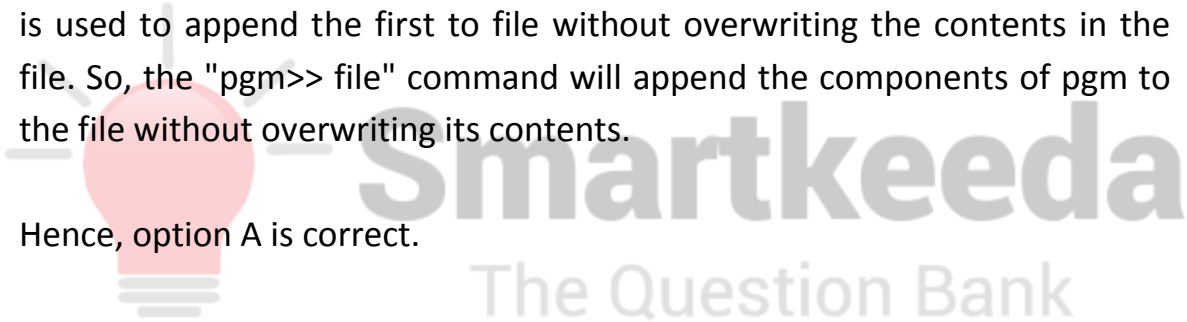

The "command >> file" is used to append the first to file without overwriting the contents in the file. So, the "pgm>> file" command will append the components of pgm to the file without overwriting its contents.
