Stumbling Block: A circumstance that causes difficulty or hesitation.

Ex: The country's water shortage was a stumbling block to investors.

Consecration refers to blessing.

Assistance meaning help, is opposite to the correct meaning.

Slab of rock takes the phrase in the literal sense and is incorrect.

Only Impediment, meaning obstacle fits in.

Hence, option B is correct.

2.

Bode: refers to forecasting/indicate/augur

Something bodes well when the clues or signs imply a favorable outcome.

Ex: Because I am a light sleeper, the dog's barking does not bode well for my desire to take a nap.

Definite and certain are the opposite of indicate and incorrect.

lues is irrelevant.

Only augur meaning foretell/portend/signify/bode is correct.

Hence, option D is correct.

3.

Draw the last straw: To obtain the least favorable, desirable, or fortunate outcome in a given selection.

Ex: I drew the short straw when it came to cleaning up after our shift last night.

Desired result is the opposite of what is meant by the idiom.

Exaggerate means to overstate/amplify something.

Camouflage means to hide something.

Unfavorable outcome fits in well.

Hence, option A is correct.

4.

Collaboration: To work jointly on an activity or project.

Ex: He collaborated with him on numerous hotel projects.

Berate means to scold severely and is irrelevant.

Distinctly is opposite to the correct meaning.

Recuperate is to recover.

Mutually means together and is correct.

Hence, option C is correct.

5.

Hold one's breath: . Be excited, anxious, or nervous. In the above context, the phrase is negative.

Ex: The election was so close that I held my breath until the final results were in.

Option A is absurd. Out of the rest, only option B fits in with the context.

Hence, option B is correct.

6.

No match: If one person or thing is no match for another, they are unable to compete successfully with the other person or thing.

Ex: I was no match for a man with such power.

Great and superior are opposite of the correct meaning.

Allies is irrelevant.

Only Inferior fits in.

Hence, option A is correct.

7.

Hand down: Pass on by tradition, inheritance etc.

Ex: My clothes were handed down to me by my older sister.

Sentenced means to punish and is incorrect.

Passed over means overlooked for something.

Option D is absurd.

Only Pass on makes sense here.

Hence, option C is correct.

8.

Hit on: Find unexpectedly or by inspiration.

Ex: As she watched the news she hit upon an idea for her new collection.

Device means an equipment and is incorrect.

Assume means to suppose something and is irrelevant.

Neglect means to ignore/overlook and is incorrect.

Only discover matches with the meaning given above.

Hence, option C is correct.

9.

Keep at something: to continue working hard at something difficult.

Ex: Learning a language is hard, but you just have to keep at it.

Out of all the options, only persevere which means to persist/continue is correct.

Hence, option B is correct.

10.

Joined in: to become involved in an activity with other people.

Ex: The discussion started between Suneeta and me, but then everyone joined in.

Invited is incorrect as the parties participate on their own.

Engaging means interesting and is incorrect.

Unite means to join/mix and does not make sense here.

Only participate is correct.

Hence, option A is correct.



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
