1. IIT Madras has recently signed an agreement with ExxonMobil Research for research in the area of energy and biofuels. This will be a partnership for 5 years and it will focus on biogas, data analytics, gas conversion and transport. Since India is the 3rd highest producer of bio-fuels in India, this is going to ensure that India can make efficient use of the resources in this area.

Hence, option A is correct.

2. IIT Kharagpur student Debayan Saha has developed a device "PM 2.5" in order to curb air pollution in the country. According to the research, this device has to be fitted near the silencer of a car so that air pollution can be curbed. It combines electric energy and wave energy so that air pollution due to cars can be eliminated.

Hence, option A is correct.

3. Rupa Gurunath has been appointed as the first ever female President of the Tamil Nadu Cricket Association. With this she has become the first ever woman to head a state-level cricket body in the country.

Hence, option C is correct.

4. Great Britain defeated India in the finals of the Sultan of Johor Tournament 2019 held in Malaysia. It was the 9th edition of the tournament and Great Britain has won it for the third time this year. Japan's Kosei Kawabe has been named as the Best Player of the Tournament.

Hence, option B is correct.

5. The Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Kamal Nath, has recently announced that the new metro project in Bhopal will be named as Raja Bhoj. The Chief Minister has recently laid the foundation stone of this project for an amount of Rs 6941.4 crores. Raja Bhoj is the 11th century ruler from the Parmar dynasty in the state.

Hence, option A is correct.

6. India has been ranked at 44th as per the World Digital Competitiveness Index by the IMD World Competitiveness Centre. USA has been ranked as the most digitally competitive country whereas Singapore comes after that. The main motive of this report is to measure 63 countries based on their readiness to integrate technology in economic transformation of the country.

7. Tamil Nadu has recently become the first ever state in the country to enact a law on contract farming. The state assembly has recently enacted the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Produce and Livestock Contract Farming Services (Promotion and Facilitation) Act 2019 the objective of which is to create a framework for contract farming in the areas of agricultural products and livestock contract farming.

8. Former Mumbai Police Commissioner Datta Padsalgikar has recently been appointed as the Deputy National Security Advisor of India. He was an IPS Officer of the 1982 batch and served in the Intelligence Bureau as well during her career. He retired as the Director General of Police in 2018.

9. The national carrier of India, Air India, has recently become the first ever airline to use a Taxibot on an Airbus. Taxibot is robot-used tractor used for taxiing an aircraft from the parking bay to runway and vice versa. It will help in

decongesting boarding gates and the apron area by providing efficient pushbacks.

Hence, option A is correct.

10. According to the Union Minister of State for Home Affairs the Census in the year 2021 is going to be conducted in 16 languages. The census will be conducted in two phases – house listing and housing census along with population enumeration in two phases. The total exercise is going to cost Rs 8754.23 crores.

11. Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) has become the first ever municipal corporation in the country to install Reverse Transcription – Polymerase Chain Reaction machines for ready detection of diseases such as swine flu, dengue and tuberculosis. This machine will act as the 'third umpire' in cases where the medical results and blood tests will reveal contradictory results for a patient.

Hence, option B is correct.

12. The International Astronomical Union has recently named an asteroid after the name of Pandit Jasraj, an Indian classical singer. The asteroid is located between Mars and Jupiter. It was previously known as a minor planet and was first discovered in 2006 by Catalina Sky Survey.

Hence, option B is correct.

13. The World Sindhi Congress arranged the 31st International Conference on Sindh in London, UK. The main focus of the summit was on forced conversion of religion, human rights violations, enforced disappearances of activists etc. in Pakistan. The summit also condemned Pakistan for its failure to protect the human rights of the people in the country.

Hence, option A is correct.

14. Nepal Rashtra Bank has recently issued the commemorative coins of Rs 100, 1000 and 2500 Nepali Rupees on the occasion of the 550th birth anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev ji. In the function, a book titled 'Sikh Heritage in Nepal' has been published to recognize the Sikh heritage in Nepal during the British rule.

15. Saad Hariri was the former PM of Lebanon who had to resign bowing to the anti-government supporters. The country is now facing one of the worst financial crisis in which the debt of the country now stands at \$86 billion, which is 150% of the total gross domestic product of the country. The PM had to resign since it was the first and foremost demand of the protestors in the recent two-week long protests in the country.

Hence, option A is correct.

16. The Financial Action Task Force (FATF) has recently removed Sri Lanka from the 'Grey List' since the organization has admitted that the country has made considerable progress in the area of terror financing and anti-money laundering activities. In October 2016, FATF put Sri Lanka in this list since it thought of putting it under the watch list.

17. The World Statistics Day is observed on October 20 in order to recognize the importance of national statistical capability. The theme of the event is: 'Better Data, Better Lives'. The first World Statistics Day was observed in 2010 as per the resolution and it was an overwhelming success with 130 countries arranging activities on that day.

18. Religare Health Insurance and PNB MetLife have signed an agreement for distribution of a special health insurance product aimed at critical illness, health and death. 23. Tapan Kumar Mishra from Odisha has recently been honoured with the National Tourism Award for the year 2017-18 during the celebration of the World Tourism Day. He has been honoured since he has travelled with one tourist for 965 days in a span of 8 years in which he has travelled 26 states along with that tourist. Tapan Mishra works as a freelance tourist guide approved by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.
