Explanation:

1. Women's Boxing Icon Nicola Adams has recently announced retirement from the international arena due to her falling physical condition. She became the first ever women's boxing champion in Olympics in 2012 and she emulated that performance again in the year 2016 by winning the second gold medal in boxing.

Hence, option B is correct.

2. According to the decision taken in the executive meeting of the International Hockey Federation, it has been decided that India will host the men's hockey world cup 2023 edition. It will be held from January 13 to January 29, 2023 in the country. Apart from this, the 2022 women's hockey world cup has been scheduled to be held in Spain and the Netherlands.

Hence, option D is correct.

3. Sri Lanka has recently become the first ever country from South Asia to declare match fixing a crime according to its bill related to offences in sports. As per the new law, any person found guilty of match fixing related crimes will have to face imprisonment for a period of 10 years and he will also have to pay other related fines to the law enforcement authorities.

Hence, option B is correct.

4. Facebook has entered into an agreement with ICC in order to have the exclusive rights for the matches to be conducted in South Asia. This will include the women's world T20 matches and also the men's cricket world cup 2023. This social media platform is also going to have the rights for recap of matches for the rest of the world.

Hence, option B is correct.

5. China has recently launched the first ever satellite of Sudan named as SRSS 1 from the Long March 4B Rocket for promoting space technology and military research by the country. This satellite has been developed for remote sensing over Sudan and it also aims at advancement in space technology in that country.

Hence, option C is correct.

6. China has recently approved a drug named GV 971 to treat the Alzheimer's disease. The medicine has been developed after research of 22 years. It is an oral drug and the first in the world to be carbohydrate-based and it will be available to the general public from December 2019.

Hence, option C is correct.

7. Japan has launched the biggest transport ship of the world for the space station as the country launched the H12B Rocket to the International Space Station. It is the biggest transport ship that will carry total weight of 5.3 tonnes of supplies to the astronauts at the International Space Station.

Hence, option D is correct.

8. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has tied with IBM to build the SkillsBuild platform in the country. according to this initiative a course will be provided based on IT, cloud computing and software development in all the ITIs and NSTIs. The faculties of these institutes will be trained accordingly by IBM.

Hence, option D is correct.

9. The biennial Conference of the Commonwealth Law Ministers was organized in Sri Lanka in November 2019. The theme of the conference was 'Equal Access to Justice and the Rule of Law'. The main objective of the summit was to provide equal access to all the population of the member countries to justice and law so that the legal disputes are settled amicably and effectively in the countries.

Hence, option D is correct.

10. According to the India Judicial Report 2019, Maharashtra has topped the list among states in delivering justice to its citizens and it is followed by Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Punjab and Haryana. Jharkhand, Bihar and Uttar Pradesh have been placed at the bottom of the list. This report has been published in collaboration with Tata Trusts and also among the smaller states; Goa has topped the list among states.

Hence, option B is correct.

11. Kerala government has recently signed a MoU with Maldives in order to improve the cancer care treatment in the island nation. Under this arrangement, the Indian state has decided to coordinate with the island nation regarding the cancer treatment. The Kerala Health Minister has signed the agreement with the Maldives ministry.

Hence, option E is correct.

12. Uttar Pradesh CM Yogi Adityanath has recently announced annual aid for an amount of Rs 6000 for the triple talaq victims in the state. The victims of triple talaq is to be covered under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram and several other welfare measures are going to be adopted by the government for such victims.

Hence, option B is correct.

13. ADB has signed an agreement to finance the Chennai-Kanyakumari Power Corridor Link for an amount of Rs 3200 crores. The government will provide \$202.5 million out of the total project. The project is going to be completed by the year 2024 and on completion it will provide better power supply to the industrial and domestic areas of the state.

14. The 6th Parliamentary Summit for Speakers has been organized in Tokyo, Japan in 2019. The summit is organized for the members of the G20 countries and in this summit there were mainly three themes – trade, technology and sustainable development. It also discussed regarding the terrorism aspects in the member countries.

Hence, option E is correct.

15. Thailand has become the first ever Asian country to roll out plain cigarette packaging so that the appeal of smoking gets reduced in the country. With this, the country has also complied with the guidelines of the World Health Organization. In 2012, Australia was the first ever country to start with plain cigarette packaging so that the smoking habit is reduced among the masses of the country.

Hence, option E is correct.

16. MSTC Limited has recently signed an agreement with Allahabad Bank for an integrated e-auction platform. This will be integrated with the platform of the Indian Banks' Association (IBA) and it can be used for sale of assets under the SARFAESI Act 2002. This will help in reduction of NPAs for the banking system and the bidder once registered in this system will be able to participate in the auctions for all the banks.

Hence, option E is correct.

17. The Export Import Bank of India (EXIM Bank) has recently granted \$30 million credit line to Ghana for a potable drinking water project in the country. Under this arrangement products that can be exported from India will be financed by EXIM Bank and also permissible under the Foreign Trade Policy of India as of 2019. The terminal utilization time is 60 months period after the scheduled completion of the project.

Hence, option B is correct.

18. Wing Commander Anjali Singh has been nominated as the first ever female diplomat from India to be attached to the Indian mission in Russia. She has served Indian Air Force for 17 years and is trained in MIG 29 aircraft. She has been posted as the Deputy Air Attaché of the country who is expected to coordinate with the civilian administration.

Hence, option C is correct.

19. Tech Mahindra has recently acquired BORN Group with an estimated amount of \$95 million. It is a digital content and production company and the acquisition is going to provide Tech Mahindra with better customer experience from all over the world. BORN Group is into consulting, hosting, content creation etc.

Hence, option E is correct.

20. Airtel Payments Bank has partnered with HDFC Ergo General Insurance Company to provide the innovative Mosquito Diseases Protection Policy to the subscribers. This will protect the policyholders against seven mosquito-borne diseases such as malaria, Zika, Chikungunya etc. The scheme will be offered for an annual premium of Rs 99 to the customers.

Hence, option C is correct.

21. Pepsico India has been chosen for the US Award for Corporate Excellence in the year 2019. The US Vice President Mike Pompeo has given the award to the company and the reason is that the company saved water by doing various community development programs and also by saving water by impacting a large population of the country.

Hence, option A is correct.

22 Neeraj Sharma has been honoured with the 'Early Career Researcher of the Year' Award 2019 for his outstanding contribution to science, by the Government of Australia. Neeraj developed a special kind of battery that will have minimal impact on the environment. Neeraj Sharma is a researcher at the University Of South Wales School Of Chemistry.

Hence, option A is correct.

23. Kumar Mangalam Birla from Aditya Birla Group has been honoured with the ABLF Global Asian Award in the year 2019. The award has been given for his excellence in business leadership that has attracted international attention and interest. This award is backed by UAE Government mainly and is related to talks, publications and awards.
