1. Mouse, Scanner and Keyboard is Input Devices and printer is an output device.

Hence, option C is correct.

2. Provides sequential access only Magnetic disk

Magnetic Disk: - The primary computer storage device. Like tape, it is magnetically recorded and can be re-recorded over and over. Disks are rotating platters with a mechanical arm that moves a read/write head between the outer and inner edges of the platter's surface. It can take as long as one second to find a location on a floppy disk to as little as a couple of milliseconds on a fast hard disk.

Hence, option D is correct.

3. The physical components of a computer system is called Hardware

Computer hardware refers to the physical parts of a computer and related devices. Internal hardware devices include motherboards, hard drives, and RAM. External hardware devices include monitors, keyboards, mice, printers, and scanners.

Hence, option B is correct.

4. Monitor: - It is a display screen used to provide visual output from a computer.

Hence, option A is correct.

5. Printer: It is a output device that accepts text and graphic output from a computer and transfers the information to paper.

Hence, option B is correct.

The pattern of printed lines on most products are called barcodes. A barcode is an optical machine-readable representation of data relating to the object to which it is attached. Originally barcodes systematically represented data by varying the widths and spacing of parallel lines, and may be referred to as linear or one-dimensional (1D). Later two-dimensional (2D) codes were developed, using rectangles, dots, hexagons and other geometric patterns in two dimensions, usually called barcodes although they do not use bars as such. Barcodes originally were scanned by special optical scanners called barcode readers.



Hence, option D is correct.

7. An output device that visually conveys text, graphics, and video information. Information shown on a display device is called soft copy and printed data on a paper or other object is called hardcopy.

Hence, option A is correct.

- **8.** Ctrl is used in keyboard shortcut key such as the three finger salute or CTRL + ALT + DEL. This key combination suggests pressing and holding down the CTRL, ALT, and DEL keyboard keys to open the Task Manager or reboot the computer. Below are some other commonly used Ctrl shortcut keys on a Windows computer.
 - **Ctrl + A -** These two keys will select all text or other objects.
 - Ctrl + B Bold highlighted text.
 - **Ctrl + C** Copy any selected text or other object. See Control C definition for further information.
 - **Ctrl + V -** Paste any text or other object that has been copied.
 - **Ctrl + X -** Cut selected text or other object.
 - **Ctrl + Z Pressing** these two keys will undo any action.

Hence, option D is correct.



9. Short for numeric lock or number lock, the Num Lock key is located on the top left corner of the numeric keypad of the keyboard and enables and disables the numeric pad.

Turning the Num Lock on allows you to use the numbers on the keypad and turning the Num Lock off enables the key's other functions, such as using the keypad as an arrow pad. The picture shows what the Num Lock key with an LED may look like on a keyboard.



Hence, option A is correct.



10. In the general meaning of input is to provide or give something to the computer, in other words the state/act of a computer, component of a computer or relevant device being accepting something from the user, from a device or from a piece of software either automatically or manually is called input.
