## Answers:

1. An output device is any piece of computer hardware item used to communicate the results of data processing carried out by an information processing system which converts the electronically generated information into human-readable form.

Plotter: It's a computer printer for printing vector graphics. Earlier, plotters were used in applications such as computer-aided design, though they have generally been replaced with wideformat conventional printers. A plotter gives a hard copy of the output. It draws pictures on a paper using a pen. Plotters are used to print designs of ships and machines, plans for buildings and so on.

Printer: It is a device that accepts text and graphic output from a computer and transfers the information to paper.

Monitor: It is a display screen used to provide visual output from a computer.
Hence, option D is correct.
2. An input device is a peripheral (piece of computer hardware equipment) used to provide data and control signals to an information processing system such as a computer or information appliance. Examples of input devices include keyboards, mouse, scanners, digital cameras and joysticks.

Hence, option D is correct.

Enter Key: The enter key in most cases causes a command line, window form, or dialog box to operate its default function. This is typically to finish an "entry" and begin the desired process, and is usually an alternative to pressing an OK button.

1. Pointing: Move the mouse to move the on-screen pointer.
2. Clicking: Press and release the left mouse button once.
3. Double-Clicking: Press and release the left mouse button twice.
4. Dragging: Hold down the left mouse button as you move the pointer.
5. Right-Clicking: Press and release the right mouse button. It's through we can access the properties of any object.

Hence, option C is correct.
