Answers:

1. The logical unit in CPU as the name suggest is used to perform the logical and the arithmetic operation in a computer. It is the fundamental building block of the CPU.

4. USB is short for Universal Serial Bus, it is a type of computer port which can be used to connect various equipments to a computer.

An example of a USB is the USB cord of cell phones used to upload pictures to a computer.

Booting is the process and set of operations that loads and starts the operating system from the point where the user clicks on the power button. From the pressing of the power button to the appearance of the login screen there are more than hundred components/peripherals that are initialized and thousand lines of code is executed during the process of booting making sure all startup applications and services are launched properly and completely.

Relational database management systems (RDBMS) supports the relational data model i.e. it provides a system where a record means value of a row in the table and schema of table is created using table names, specific values and required types of data. The table schemas are finally structured using normalization. Microsoft Access is a database management system (DBMS) from Microsoft that combines the relational Microsoft Jet Database Engine and works as a RDBMS, whereas Paradox is a RDBMs published by Corel Corporation it was originally released for MS DOS but now works on Windows as well.

7. A Volatile memory is a type of computer storage that only maintains its data till the device is powered on. Most RAM (random access memory) used in primary storage in personal computers consists of volatile memory.
