Who: Squid Game actor O Yeong-su

What: wins South Korea's first Golden Globe Award

When: published on 11th January 2022

South Korean actor O Yeong-su won the country's first Golden Globe award on Sunday for his role in Netflix hit Squid Game drawing cheers at home and abroad despite criticism for the ceremony's organisers over a lack of diversity.

O, 77, won best supporting actor in television for his portrayal of Oh II-nam, also known as The Host or Player 001, becoming the first South Korean ever to snatch a Golden Globe.

He beat more globally renowned competitors including Billy Crudup and Kieran Culkin, who were respectively nominated for their performances in The Morning Show and Succession.

After years of being nominated for multiple awards, the seasoned actor finally won his first Golden Globe on Jan. 9. Smith is taking home the award for the Best Actor in Motion Picture Drama category after capturing the essence of Venus and Serena's father, Richard Williams, in the movie "King Richard."

Smith has been nominated for a Golden Globe for Best Actor in the aforementioned category three times for his films "Ali", "Pursuit of Happyness" and "Concussion." His final two nominations were from the Musical/Comedy Series category for Best Television Actor. Smith at the time was being recognized for one of his most popular roles — in his television sitcom "The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air." He was nominated in both 1993 and 1994.

Last year was the world's fifth hottest on record, while levels of planet-warming carbon dioxide and methane in the atmosphere hit new highs in 2021, European Union scientists said.

The EU's Copernicus Climate Change Service (C3S) said in a report on Monday that the last seven years were the world's warmest "by a clear margin" in records dating back to 1850 and the average global temperature in 2021 was 1.1-1.2C above 1850-1900 levels.

In the women's singles, Sindhu is seeded first with Saina seeded fourth. The matches will be held at the KD Jadhav Indoor Hall, IG Stadium in the national capital. The India Open badminton tournament, a BWF World Tour Super 500 series, is back after a two-year gap due to the coronavirus pandemic.

It's not clear why the company withdrew ahead of schedule, but Vivo had in 2020 pulled out as IPL sponsor after the Galwan Valley military face-off between India and China. At that time, mobile gaming platform Dream11 had stepped in as title sponsor for a year. Vivo was back in 2021 and could have continued this year as well.
