Who: Renowned Bengali theatre personality Shaoli Mitra

What: passes away

When: published on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022

Indian theatre personality Shaoli Mitra is dead. The veteran actress passed away at her Kolkata residence on Sunday evening due to age-related ailments. Reports suggest she was suffering from heart-related ailments for a long time but had refused to be hospitalised. She was 74.

Daughter of legendary theatre artistes Sambhu Mitra and Tripti Mitra, Shaoli Mitra was cremated at Sirtri crematorium just like her father, without much fanfare.

Shaoli, who was the recipient of Sangeet Natak Akademi in 2003, Padma Shri in 2009, and Banga Bibhusan in 2012, will be remembered by her fans and critics alike for her solo performances as Draupadi in 'Naathvati Anaathbat' (which she also wrote and directed), and as Sita in 'Sitakatha' or Bitata Bitangso.

He breathed his last at a private hospital here while undergoing treatment for Covid related complications, they said.

Prasad, 89, is survived by his wife and two children. His cremation was held at a crematorium in Ravipuram here.

An all-time source of energy for environmental activists, Prasad gave effective leadership to a progressive people's science movement called "Kerala Sasthra Sahithya Parishath" (KSSP).

As the lead activist of KSSP, Prasad was a guiding force behind the national movement against the state government's move to set up a hydro-power project in Silent Valley in Palakkad district in the 1970s.

The 20-year-old Sen, who had claimed his maiden world championships medal with a bronze in Spain last month, produced a fine performance to outshine the fifth seeded shuttler 24-22 21-17 in the summit clash that lasted 54 minutes.

Under a public-private partnership (PPP) framework, the project involves the development, funding, building, and operation of the 400kV Lessos – Loosuk and 220kV Kisumu – Musaga transmission lines. When finished, the project will be Kenya's first Independent Power Transmission (IPT) and will serve as a benchmark in Africa as the first PPP-based financing of transmission lines. This project will also improve power transmission supply and reliability in Western Kenya, as well as create a demonstration effect to encourage private sector investment in the expansion of Africa's power transmission networks, which is critical to bridging the continent's electricity access gap.
