

What: launches Horticulture Week, aimed at doubling farmers' income

When: published on 14th July 2021

Continuing the Government's endeavours to realize Prime Minister's goal of doubling the income of farmers by 2022, Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha on Wednesday launched the Horticulture Week by planting saplings at Akhnoor on the city outskirts.

The Horticulture Week from July 14 to 20 in the UT shall focus on the broad contours of initiating massive Plantation Drives, taking objective steps in Nursery Development, promoting mechanisation among the farming community, Creation of Water Sources, Human Resource Development through training and strengthening the Post Harvest Management with the overall mission of doubling the farmers' income in the Union Territory.

The Lt Governor observed that the government has set an unprecedented target of planting 25 lakh high-density plants this year as compared to 49,000 in the year 2019, which is a new record in the history of horticulture of Jammu division.

In 2021, the World Youth Skills Day will again take place in a challenging context. The COVID-19 pandemic continues, reaching a scale that could hardly have been anticipated one year ago. While vaccinations offer hope to bring the situation under control in several high-income countries, major emerging countries are facing severe outbreaks that overwhelm their health infrastructure. Education and training systems have yet to return to pre-pandemic conditions. Respondents to a survey of TVET institutions jointly collected by UNESCO, the International Labour Organization and the World Bank reported that distance training had become the most common way of imparting skills, with considerable difficulties regarding, among others, curricula adaptation, trainee and trainer preparedness, connectivity, or assessment and certification processes.

The Indian Space Research Organisation (Isro) on Wednesday successfully conducted the third long-duration hot test on the liquid propellant Vikas engine that would launch the ambitious Gaganyaan programme.

The test of the liquid propellant Vikas engine was done for the core L110 liquid stage of the human rated GSLV MkIII vehicle, as part of the engine qualification requirements for the Gaganyaan programme, Isro said in a statement.

The engine was fired for 240 seconds at the test facility of Isro Propulsion Complex (IPRC), Mahendragiri in Tamil Nadu.

As per the statement, the performance of the engine met the test objectives and the engine parameters were closely matching with the predictions during the entire duration of the test.

The partnership, apart from increasing the access to COVID-19 testing, will also support research to better help understand the virus, its variants and manage future outbreaks, IFC and MedGenome said in a statement on Thursday.

IFC's \$16.5 million equity investment will support the expansion of MedGenome's diagnostic services as well as boost genomic data from South Asian populations, which can help provide valuable insights into complex diseases and help develop effective medical solutions for diverse populations, it added.

What: restricts Mastercard from acquiring new customers from July 22

When: published on 14th July 2021

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Wednesday barred Mastercard Asia Pacific from onboarding new debit, credit, or prepaid card customers from July 22, 2021, for failing to comply with its data storage norms. The central bank said that Mastercard failed to comply with the "directions on Storage of Payment System Data" even after being given "considerable time and adequate opportunities." According to the RBI, the restrictions will not impact existing customers of Mastercard.

"Mastercard shall advise all card issuing banks and non-banks to conform to these directions," it added.

In terms of its circular on Storage of Payment System Data issued on April 6, 2018, the RBI had directed all system providers to ensure that within a period of six months the entire data relating to payment systems operated by them is stored in a system only in India. The data include full end-to-end transaction details; information collected, carried, processed as part of the message; and payment instruction.

What: Extended the Implementation Timeline of ATM Cassette Swap till March 2022

When: published on 14th July 2021



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has extended the timeline for implementation of cassette swap in all ATMs till March 31, 2022.

This comes in the wake of the Indian Banks' Association making a representation on behalf of various banks, expressing difficulties in meeting the March 31, 2021 timeline.

Based on the recommendations of the Committee on Currency Movement (CCM), RBI, in April 2018, had advised that banks may consider using lockable cassettes in their ATMs, which shall be swapped at the time of cash replenishment. This is aimed at mitigating risks involved in open cash replenishment/top-up.

The RBI then said cassette swap in ATMs may be implemented in a phased manner, covering at least one third ATMs operated by the banks every year, such that all ATMs achieve cassette swap by March 31, 2021.

Telangana is all set to celebrate the 'Asha Bonalu' festival, one of the biggest traditional folk festivals in the state, on Sunday. The event was cancelled by the state government last year in view of the coronavirus disease (Covid-19) pandemic. The Bonalu festival was declared a 'state festival' by the K Chandrasekhar Rao-led government after the state's formation back in 2014.

The Bonalu festival involves scores of devotees offering the traditional 'bonam' (derived from Bhojanam, meaning meals) to the goddess Mahankali at 25 temples across the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad. The first of these offerings -- the 'golden bonam' -- will be offered to the goddess Jagdamba at the temple in Hyderabad's Golconda Fort at 12 noon.

The Bonalu festival, a month-long event, is expected to see a heavy rush from women devotees this year since many were restricted from properly making their offerings last year in view of the Covid-19 curbs. According to reports, the authorities are expecting thousands of devotees to crowd the temple premises on weekdays.

The wholesale price-based inflation eased marginally to 12.07 per cent in June as crude oil and food items witnessed some softening in prices.

However, WPI inflation remained in double digit for the third consecutive month in June, mainly due to a low base of last year. WPI inflation was (-) 1.81 per cent, in June 2020.

Snapping the five straight months of uptick, the wholesale price index (WPI)-based inflation in June softened as prices of food articles and crude oil eased, even though manufactured products hardened.

What: hikes DA from 17% to 28% for employees from July 1

When: published on 15th July 2021

The Cabinet has approved a 11 percentage point hike in Dearness Allowance (DA) and Dearness Relief (DR) for central government employees and pensioners effective July 1. With this, the new DA rate will be 28 per cent, up from 17 per cent.

The DA and DR were frozen last year as the pandemic hit the country.

After the Cabinet meeting, Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur told reporters: "In view of the unprecedented situation which arose due to the Covid-19 pandemic, three additional instalments of Dearness Allowance to the central government employees and Dearness Relief to the pensioners, which were due from January 1, 2020; July 1, 2020; and January 1, 2021, had been frozen."

The appointment also takes significance as the monsoon session of Parliament is set to commence on July 19. It will conclude on August 13.

Goyal has been a member of the upper house of the parliament since 2010. Until now, he was the deputy leader of the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) in the Rajya Sabha. He holds key portfolios in the cabinet including commerce and industry, food and consumer affairs.

After the recent rejig in the Union cabinet, Goyal was given additional charge of textiles. Prior to becoming a minister in 2014, Goyal was the treasurer of the party. He was also engaged by the BJP in poll management activities and logistics during the election.
