Arunachal Pradesh government has inked an agreement with the Indian Institute of Management Shillong here to foster better financial and policy management aimed at improving livelihoods.

Arunachal Pradesh chief secretary Naresh Kumar and IIM Shillong director DP Goyal signed the MoU in the presence of Chief Minister Pema Khandu on Friday.

"The MoU is aimed at fostering mutual agreement between the Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Centre for Policy Research Analysis of IIM Shillong and the Finance Planning and Investment Department of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh," IIM Shillong said in a statement.

It said the MoU recognises the Dr APJ Centre of IIM Shillong as an official Think Tank and Knowledge partner of the state government of Arunachal Pradesh.

"IIM Shillong will assist the government of Arunachal Pradesh in developing policies and roadmap for business development in handloom, horticulture, tourism, logistics and BPO sector, etc," it added.

Corteva will co-lead the project as the technology and knowledge partner for DSR.

What: Collaborates With Ladakh Officials For Boosting Unique Agricultural Produce Which Would Boost Farmers' Income In The Region

For giving boost to exports of agricultural produce from Ladakh, which would enhance farmers' as well as entrepreneurs' income, APEDA in association with officials of the horticulture, agriculture, commerce and industry departments of Union Territory and Defence Institute of High-Altitude Research (DIHAR) are working out comprehensive plan of actions.

Following a series of interactions held recently at Ladakh, identified areas of work include enhancement of production of fruits with medicinal values including sea buckthorn, apricot and organic produce and introduction of the traceability system, capacity-building of farmers and value addition of products.

APEDA would provide technical assistance for building the capacity of stakeholder including entrepreneurs, officials, farmers, branding and marketing of Ladakhi products and making Ladakh an 'organic' region. APEDA would provide special assistance for branding and promotion of Ladakhi products, especially sea buckthorn which is rich in Vitamin C, omega and other essential nutrients.

The mission was previously supposed to take off on NASA's own Space Launch System (SLS) rocket, which has been plagued by delays and cost overruns, with critics calling it a "jobs program" for the state of Alabama where much of the development work is taking place.

Over 1,44,000 people drowned in the Asia Pacific region in 2019, accounting for 61 per cent of global drowning deaths, according to the first World Health Organization regional assessments on drowning prevention.

The reports, which have been released ahead of World Drowning Prevention Day on Sunday, stated that drowning claimed the lives of an estimated 70,000 and 74,000 people in the South-East Asia and Western Pacific regions.

The Regional Status Report on Drowning in the Western Pacific and Regional Status Report on Drowning in South-East Asia, also warn that climate change, to which the Asia Pacific region is particularly vulnerable, puts already vulnerable communities and individuals at increased drowning risk.

More frequent and extreme weather events can lead to more regular and intense floods, increasing populations" exposure to potentially hazardous interactions with water, the reports said.
