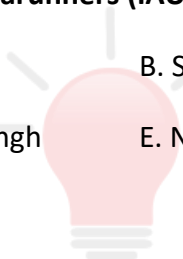

What: Launched 'Udaan' Scheme To Distribute Sanitary Pads To Women Every Month

When: published on 28th May 2021

The Punjab government on the occasion of International Menstrual Hygiene Day on Friday launched a scheme to provide free sanitary napkins to needy girls and women across the state.

An amount of Rs 40.55 crore per annum will be incurred on the scheme, called 'Udaan', Punjab Social Security, Women and Child Development Minister Aruna Chaudhary said in a statement.

The new scheme would cover school drop-outs, out-of-school girls, young women not attending college, women from BPL families, homeless women, residents of slum areas, and those who are not availing free or subsidised sanitary pads under any scheme of other departments, she said.

Bharti Global-backed OneWeb, which is a Low Earth Orbit (LEO) satellite communications operator, has launched its next batch of 36 satellites. The satellites were launched by Arianespace from the Vostochny cosmodrome in Russia.

With the latest launch, OneWeb's total in-orbit constellation stands at 218 satellites. These would be a part of OneWeb's 648 LEO satellite fleet that will look to deliver high-speed, low-latency global connectivity by next year.



The launch represents the fourth in a five-launch programme that looks to fulfil the 'Five to 50' service, which will enable OneWeb to offer connectivity across the UK, Alaska, Northern Europe, Greenland, the Arctic Seas and Canada. The company expects the service to be switched on before the end of the year.

In a statement, IFFCO said that the "World's 1st Nano Urea Liquid" was unveiled during its 50th annual general body meeting, which was held online-offline mode.

"IFFCO Nano Urea Liquid is developed to replace conventional urea and it can curtail the requirement of the same by at least 50%. It contains 40,000 ppm of nitrogen in a 500 ml bottle which is equivalent to the impact of nitrogen nutrient provided by one bag of conventional urea," the statement said.

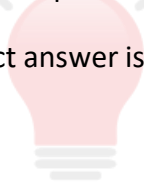

What: approves 'second Indigenisation list' of 108 items to boost 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'

When: published on 31st May 2021

Taking the clarion call of 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' ahead and to boost indigenisation in the Defence sector, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has approved a proposal of the Department of Military Affairs, Ministry of Defence (MoD) to notify the 'Second Positive Indigenisation List' of 108 items. This will further give a boost to indigenisation with the active participation of the public and private sectors for fulfilling the twin objectives of achieving self-reliance and promoting defense exports. All the 108 items will now be procured from indigenous sources as per provisions given in Defence Acquisition Procedure (DAP) 2020.

The second list lays special focus on weapons/systems which are currently under development/trials and are likely to translate into firm orders in the future. Like the first list, import substitution of ammunition which is a recurring requirement has been given special focus. The list recognizes the potential of the local defense industry while it will also encourage domestic Research & Development by attracting fresh investment into technology and manufacturing capabilities.

Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar on Monday launched a programme for integrated and market-led development of 53 horticulture clusters, which have the potential to help 10 lakh farmers and attract Rs 10,000 crore investment.

The minister launched Horticulture Cluster Development Programme (CDP) in a virtual event, an official statement said.

Tomar highlighted that the programme will address all major issues related to the Indian horticulture sector including pre-production, production, post-harvest management, logistics, marketing and branding.

The programme is designed to leverage geographical specialisation and promote integrated and market-led development of horticulture clusters, he added.

The ministry has identified 53 horticulture clusters, of which 12 have been selected on a pilot basis.



Stating that "Doubling farmers" income is one of the biggest priorities of the government, Tomar said the CDP will benefit about 10 lakh farmers and related stakeholders of the value chain.

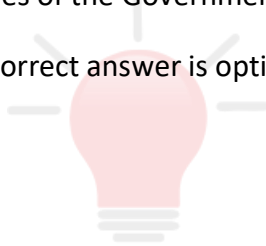
The government of Andhra Pradesh has passed an order and accorded administrative sanction to the State Skill Development Corporation for the establishment of one skill development university and 30 skill development colleges across the state.

One college will be set up in each of the 25 parliamentary constituency, one each will be set up in IITs across the state and one will be set up in Pulivendila, Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy's constituency.

The budget for creation posts, including non-recurring and recurring expenditure has been proposed for Rs 1,211.65 crores (capital expenditure) and Rs 173.88 Crores (annual average operating expense over the Year 3 to Year 8).

Each skill college will have a capital expenditure of Rs 20 crores. For the operating expenditure, funds from the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gramercy Kaushal Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana and other schemes of the Government of India will be used.
