A new grass species has been discovered in the Nigidi forest of Anantapur district. The grass species has been named after reputed botanist Dr PV Prasanna, scientist G, Botanical Survey of India (BSI).

Andhra Pradesh Biodiversity Board research scientist Dr Kothareddy Prasad, who discovered the new species, said: "The new grass species belongs to the genus 'Lophopogon' and rice family. It is named as Lophopogon prasannae." Dr Prasanna is a grass taxonomist and head of office, Deccan Regional Centre, BSI. Lophopogon — a genus of Indian plants in the grass family — is endemic to dry parts of India such as Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha and Tamil Nadu. It consists of two species only and the recently discovered species is the third species.
