S&P Global Ratings on Thursday revised its GDP growth forecast for India to 9.5 per cent for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2022 due to a severe Covid-19 pandemic wave. It had earlier projected a growth rate of 11 per cent.

The revised figure came just a day after US-based rating agency Moody's Investors Service slashed India's growth projection to 9.6 per cent for 2021 calendar year from its earlier estimate of 13.9 per cent.

The Indian economy contracted by 7.3 per cent in fiscal 2020-21 as the country battled the first wave of Covid-19 as against a 4 per cent growth in 2019-20.

The Reserve Bank of India has also cut the growth forecast to 9.5 per cent for the current fiscal from 10.5 per cent estimated earlier.

World Vitiligo Day 2021 is observed annually on June 25 to create awareness globally about this rare skin disease. In around 1-2 per cent of the population across the globe, people are suffering from this rare condition. Vitiligo occurs due to a lack of melanin, that is, loss of pigment creating pale white patches on the skin. Vitiligo Day was introduced as this disease is often met with misconceptions of being a transferable disease on touch.

The date, June 25 was chosen in a memorial to music artist Michael Jackson, who also suffered from this rare skin disease until his death, which occurred on June 25, 2009.



This idea was nursed by Steve Haragadon, the founder of the Vitiligo Friends network, and then developed by Ogo Maduewesi, a Nigerian vitiligo patient who is the founder and Executive Director of the Vitiligo Support and Awareness Foundation (VITSAF). The first World Vitiligo Day, also known as Vitiligo Awareness Day or Vitiligo Purple Fun Day, was observed in 2011.

Thus, to acknowledge and spread awareness about the importance of the contribution made by seafarers to world trade International Day of the Seafarer is observed annually.
