What: to be Tripled by 2030 to tackle Environment Change

When: published on 1st June 2021

Annual investments in nature-based solutions (NbS) will have to be tripled by 2030 and increase four-fold by 2050 from the current level of investments if the world is to meet its climate change, biodiversity and land degradation targets, according to a new United Nations report.

The report, titled State of Finance for Nature, found that approximately \$133 billion currently flows into nature-based solutions annually (using 2020 as base year). Public funds make up 86 per cent and private finance 14 per cent of these investments.

The report published May 27, 2021 was jointly produced by the United Nations Environment Programme, the World Economic Forum and the Economics of Land Degradation.

The labour market crisis created by the Covid-19 pandemic is far from over, and employment growth will be insufficient to make up for the losses suffered until at least 2023, a new assessment by the International Labour Organisation (ILO) showed on Wednesday.



Global unemployment is expected to stand at 205 million in 2022, surpassing the level of 187 million in 2019. This corresponds to an unemployment rate of 5.7%. Excluding the Covid-19 crisis period, such a rate was last seen in 2013.

The ILO's World Employment and Social Outlook: Trends 2021 (WESO Trends) projects that the global crisis-induced 'jobs gap' will reach 75 million in 2021, before falling to 23 million in 2022. The related gap in working-hours, which includes the jobs gap and those on reduced hours, amounts to the equivalent of 100 million full-time jobs in 2021 and 26 million full-time jobs in 2022. This shortfall in employment and working hours comes on top of persistently high pre-crisis levels of unemployment, labour underutilisation and poor working conditions, the report said.

Krishnan headed expert committee on Variable Capital Company has submitted its report on the feasibility of Variable Capital Companies in the International Financial Services Centres to the Chairperson of the International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA), Shri. Injeti Srinivas.

International Financial Services Centres Authority constituted a Committee of Experts ('the Committee') to examine the feasibility of the Variable Capital Company ('VCC') in India to examine the suitability of the Variable Capital Company as a vehicle for fund management in the International Financial Services Centre in India.

The IFSCA set up this Committee to explore the potential for allowing another legal structure – popularly known as a variable capital company (VCC) – as an additional option through which asset managers could pool the investors' funds. The VCC structure dispenses with some of the key limitations of companies and LLPs and provides for higher regulatory standards than those applicable to trusts.

What: sets new world record, runs at 120 million degrees Celsius for 101 seconds

China claims to have set a new world record after scientists managed to run their 'artificial sun' at a very high temperature for more than 100 seconds.

China's Experimental Advanced Superconducting Tokamak (EAST), in its latest experiment, generated a plasma temperature of 126 million Fahrenheit (120 million C) for 101 seconds.

The scientists didn't stop there. They also managed to crank up the device to achieve 160 million Celsius for 20 seconds.

The previous record for a maintained plasma temperature was 180 million F (100 million C) for 100 seconds.

Reports said the device, which is based at the Hefei Institutes of Physical Science, broke the previous record for maintaining a plasma temperature of 100 million degrees Celsius for 100 seconds.

What: was observed on June 4

June 4 is officially observed as the International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression, each year by the United Nations (UN). The purpose of this day is to remember, acknowledge and address the violence committed against children worldwide through war, terrorism, abduction, sexual abuse, killing, assault on schools and denial of humanitarian aids. Below, we take a look at the history and significance of the event.

On June 6, 1982, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) invaded southern Lebanon and initiated the Lebanon War against the Palestine Liberation Organisation (PLO), Syrians and Muslim forces in the region. Many Palestinian and Lebanese children were killed or injured in the war.

On August 19 of that year, the UN General Assembly held an emergency meeting and criticised the Israeli government for such acts of violence against Palestinians, which it termed "massacre." The Assembly decided to henceforth observe June 4 as the International Day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression, on an annual basis.

In football, Brazil will host Copa America for the second consecutive time after Colombia and Argentina were stripped of hosting rights for the tournament. South American soccer body CONMEBOL announced the decision hours after it ruled out Argentina amid an increase in COVID-19 cases in the country.

Colombia was removed as co-host on May 20 as street protests against President Iván Duque rocked the nation. South American teams are already training for the tournament and two rounds of World Cup qualifiers are starting this week. Like other continental tournaments, Copa America was initially scheduled for 2020, but the COVID-19 pandemic forced its postponement.

What: approval of Chinese CoronaVac COVID vaccine will be crucial to curbing pandemic

When: published on 4th June 2021

The World Health Organization (WHO) has approved a second Chinese vaccine for emergency use. CoronaVac was found to be 51% effective at preventing COVID-19 in late-stage trials, and researchers say it will be key to curbing the pandemic.

This overall protection is lower than that provided by the seven other vaccines already listed by the WHO. But, importantly, trials suggest that CoronaVac — an inactivated-virus vaccine produced by Beijing-based company Sinovac — is 100% effective at preventing severe disease and death.

“CoronaVac will significantly contribute to the global fight against COVID-19 as a safe and moderately effective SARS-CoV-2 vaccine,” says Murat Akova, a clinical researcher in infectious diseases at Hacettepe University in Ankara.
