Raina achieved this feat when he scored 12 runs in Uttar Pradesh's 77-run victory over Puducherry in what was incidentally his 300th T20. He is only the second Indian after MS Dhoni to have played that many matches in the shortest format of the game.

Virat Kohli is closest to Raina on the all-time run scorers list for Indians in T20 cricket. The Indian captain is on 7833 runs and will next be seen in the second T20I against Australia on Wednesday. Overall, Raina is the sixth highest with David Warner (8111 runs), Shoaib Malik (8603), Kieron Pollard (8839), Brendon McCullum (9922) and Chris Gayle (12,298).
