Who: HDFC Bank

What: leads peer lenders over mobile transactions despite tech glitches

When: published on 17th March 2021

Despite facing multiple technical glitches in the past two years, HDFC Bank continues to lead over ICICI Bank and Axis Bank on overall daily and absolute mobile transaction values amongst private banks, almost 1.5-2x times it competitors, data released by advisory and research firm Bernstein showed.

In spite of its scale SBIs Yono continued to lag on user usage with customers facing friction with user interface. The analysis showed that private lender Kotak Mahindra Bank had the highest transaction activity despite its low scale. (Read more)

Who: El Salvador

What: becomes first central American country to be declared malaria-free

When: published on 6th March 2021

El Salvador has become the first country in central America and the third in all Americas to get the malaria-free certificate from the World Health Organization (WHO) in recent years.

Malaria elimination certificate is awarded to a country when the chain of indigenous transmission of the disease has been disrupted nationwide for at least three consecutive years.

El Salvador, which received the certificate on February 25, 2021, didn't report a single case of malaria that was acquired locally (indigenous) since 2017. It recorded it last malaria death in 1984.

In the three decades between 1990 and 2010, the cases in the country fell from 9,000 to 26. There was only one malaria outbreak in this period in 1996.

The only other countries in the WHO Regions of Americas to have eliminated malaria in recent years are Paraguay (2018) and Argentina (2019).

Who: India and Philippines

What: most vulnerable to repeat of taper tantrum of 2013: S&P

When: published on 18th March 2021

India and the Philippines were the most vulnerable to a repeat of the taper tantrum of 2013 as reflation trades were lifting US bond yields, according to global rating agency S&P.

Rising inflation in recent months and below average real policy rates could imply quicker capital flight, prompting central banks in the two economies to hike rates, it said in a report on Wednesday.

On the other hand, stronger than normal current account levels acted as a mitigating factor to these risks, S&P said. (Read more)

What: paired with Delhi under 'Ek Bharat, Shreshtha Bharat' programme

When: published on 17th March 2021

The Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat programme, launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in 2015, celebrates the diverse culture, traditions and languages of our country. Sikkim has been paired with national capital New Delhi, under which various programmes and activities have been undertaken.

While the COVID19 pandemic has affected the schedule of Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat activities in Sikkim, these programmes have largely moved online over the past year. Webinars, where the youth of Sikkim and Delhi shared their history, tourism and culture, besides learning each others' languages, have taken the campaign forward in recent months. Sikkim director of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan Sibasis Banerjee speaks about these activities. (Read More)

What: approves MoU between India, Maldives on Cooperation in Sports & Youth Affairs

The Union Cabinet was apprised of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between the Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and the Ministry of Youth, Sports and Community Empowerment of Maldives for cooperation in Sports and Youth Affairs.



The MoU was signed in November last year. Bilateral exchange programmes in the field of sports and youth affairs between India and Maldives will help in expanding knowledge and expertise in the area of sports science, sports medicine, coaching techniques, participation in youth festivals and camps. What: to be operational in 2022

When: published on 16th March 2021

Eastern and Western Dedicated Freight Corridors will become operational in 2022 informed Railways's Minister Piyush Goyal today in Lok Sabha.

Participating in discussion on demands for grants of the Ministry of Railways for 2021-22, Mr. Goyal said, two lakh 15 thousand crore rupees have been allocated for Railways in 2021-22 Budget.

He reiterated that the Railways is the property of the country and it will not be privatized.

Highlighting the works done by the Ministry to provide convenient travel to passengers, he said, Railways is planning to start 44 Vande Bharat trains across the country. The Minister said that Railways is focusing on the safety of the passengers and asserted that no passenger was killed due to rail accidents in the last two years. (Read more)

Who: S Dhanalakshmi

What: Beats Dutee Chand to Win 100m Gold, Hima Das Disqualified after False Start

When: published on 17th March 2021

National record holder Dutee Chand was beaten to second place by S Dhanalakshmi, while Hima Das was disqualified after a false start in a much-anticipated women's 100m sprint final in the Federation Cup Senior National Athletics Championships on Tuesday.

The 22-year-old Dhanalakshmi of Tamil Nadu took the gold by clocking 11.39 seconds ahead of Dutee (11.58) of Odisha to become the fastest woman of the championships on the second day of competitions at the NIS Campus.

Another Tamil Nadu runner Archana Suseendran was third in 11.76. This was after Hima, who was running in the shorter sprint races of 100m and 200m instead of her per event 400m, was disqualified after a false start. (Read more)

The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) on Monday launched the 'UPI-help' on BHIM UPI app as a part of Digi-Help stack by NPCI, to address any issues and complaints that users might have during UPI transactions.

Now, users can register any transaction-related complaint online using their BHIM UPI App using UPI-Help. The new feature will also resolve complaints online for person-to-person transactions.

In case of pending transactions where no action is taken by the user, the UPI-Help shall also proactively attempt to auto update the final status of the transactions on the app. (Read more)

SBI was the top remitter on the UPI platform in February, while Paytm Payments Bank led the chart in the beneficiary segment, as per data published by the National Payments Corporation of India. PhonePe topped the app category on the UPI platform in terms of volume and amount involved in the transactions that it facilitated.



According to the data published by NPCI, State Bank of India (SBI) recorded 656.92 million remittance transactions in February, that is money was sent out from the bank using the UPI platform. (Read more)

The Rajasthan government will set up 100 nursery sports academies to give an opportunity to children to play in their districts in the academies, Minister of State for Youth Affairs and Sports Ashok Chandna said.

In response to the discussion on the cut motion in the state assembly, he said that 100 nursery academies will be set up in the state. Children will be given opportunity to play in their districts in the academies, which will be developed from the available resources.

He informed that a large number of private sports academies are running in the state, and complaints of charging arbitrary fees is common.

What: tie-up for India's private credit market

When: published on 15th March 2021

Kotak Investment Advisors (KIAL), the fund manager of Kotak Mahindra Group and Allianz Investment Management — the investment management arm of Germany's Allianz Group — said on Monday that they have tied up to invest in India's private credit market.

In February 2021, Allianz made its maiden investment of \$150 million in KIAL's 11th real estate debt fund that achieved a closure of \$380 million. KIAL's real estate fund primarily focuses on financing early- and late-stage projects across India.

Allianz's total private credit investments in the country is worth about \$650 million and it is looking to increase it to \$1 billion in 2021, KIAL said. A number of global investors such as Canada's CPPIB, Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan and Baring Private Equity are betting big on private credit in the country. (Read more)

What: collects Rs 26,457 crore by decreasing stakes in six DPSUs in last 5 years

The government has collected Rs 26,457 crore by decreasing its shareholding in six defence public sector undertakings (DPSUs) in the last five years, according to details provided by minister of state for Defence Shripad Naik in Rajya Sabha on Monday.

Responding to a question, Naik said a total of Rs 14,184.70 crore was collected by decreasing stakes in Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) while the amount was Rs 8,073.29 crore from Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) and Rs 2,371.19 crore from Bharat Dynamics Limited (BDL).

Similarly Rs 434.14 was fetched from Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited (MIDHANI), Rs 420.52 crore from Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers Ltd (GRESE) and Rs 974.15 crore was collected from Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL). (Read more)

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will establish a 'Space Technology Incubation Centre' (S-TIC) at the National Institute of Technology in Rourkela to carry out research and product development in space technology and applications, officials said on Friday.

The ISRO and NIT signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on Thursday for setting up the centre which will enable start-ups to build applications and products that could be used in future space missions.

"Space technology-related research and the products from the S-TIC will be utilised in future space missions and will help nation building through 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan' in space technology and applications domain," said ISRO Chairman K Sivan. (Read more)

What: gets Nabard's Rural Business Incubation Centre

When: published on 19th March 2021

To promote and encourage startups inagriculture and allied sectors, a rural business incubation centre (RBIC) is being set up at Sardarkrushinagar Dantiwada Agricultural University in Banaskantha, with a total project outlay of Rs 10.3 crore.

The incubation centre will be supported by the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (Nabard), which will provide a grant of Rs 7.81 crore for a project period of 5 years.

The centre, according to Nabard, will support startups in areas such as agriculture and allied activities as well as off-farm sector activities such as organic foods, seed ventures, soil and water management, farm mechanization, medicinal and aromatic plants and agri bio-technology, among others.
