What: launched 5 new Online Services of Women and Child Development and Mission Shakti

What: launches real-time monitoring system for toll plazas

Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari launched the real-time monitoring system for toll plazas across national highways. Through the live monitoring system, toll plazas will be able to measure the length of the traffic queue and waiting time on a real-time basis and, accordingly, come up with responses to reduce bottlenecks and improve efficiency of mandatory FASTag usage.

Apart from measuring the 'Daily Congestion Index' for each plaza, the live monitoring system will also provide details in real-time of peak-hour traffic at toll plazas. This would allow officials at the respective toll plazas to concentrate more on traffic management at that specific time daily.

According to a tweet on NHAI's official handle, "The live monitoring system for toll plazas will be used to measure queue length and waiting time on a real-time basis in a bid to provide an immediate response, reduce bottlenecks and improve the efficiency of mandatory FASTag usage. (Read more)

What: Discover 18 New Asteroids as Part of a Global Science Programme

The International Astronomical Union (IAU), an organisation that assigns official names and designations to celestial bodies, has recently confirmed the discovery of 18 new asteroids by Indian students as part of a global science programme.

The International Asteroid Discovery Project was conducted by STEM and Space, an organisation working towards the learning of astronomy and space science in India, along with the International Astronomical Search Collaboration (IASC) as part of a NASA citizen science project.

Over the last two years, 150 students from all around India participated in this two-month-long campaign to find asteroids, making this the largest asteroid discovery project in India, Mila Mitra, Cofounder and Academic Head of STEM and Space, told PTI.

In the project, the students from India, and across the globe analysed the high-quality astronomical data provided by IASC — an online scientific program for kids to discover.(Read more)

What: successfully launches Brazil's Amazonia 1 satellite, along with 18 other passenger satellites

When: published on 28th February 2021



India's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle-C51 (PSLV-C51) rocket loaded with 19 satellites from Brazil, USA and India lifted off from the rocket port at Sriharikota successfully at the precise timing at 10.24 this morning.

After four stages of separation, the rocket launched Brazil's 637 kilogram Amazonia 1 satellite, its primary passenger.

Later after a gap of more than an hour it launched the remaining 18 passenger satellites. This is the first commercial mission of New space India limited.

Amazonia-1 is the optical earth observation satellite of National Institute for Space Research (INPE).(Read more)

What: to hold additional charge of the department of revenue

When: published on 28th February 2021

Tarun Bajaj, secretary, economic affairs, was given additional charge of the department of revenue. As per an order from the appointments committee of the cabinet on Saturday, the development came as finance secretary Ajay Bhushan Pandey will retire on February 28.

"The competent authority has approved the assignment of additional charge of the post of secretary, department of revenue to Tarun Bajaj, secretary, department of economic affairs upon superannuation of Pandey," an order issued by the Appointment Committee of the Cabinet said. This committee is headed by the Prime Minister.

Bajaj will hold the additional charge "till the appointment of a regular incumbent or until further orders," the statement added. A 1988-batch IAS officer, Bajaj was appointed as the economic affairs secretary on May 1, 2020. He was serving as an additional secretary in Prime Minister's Office. (Read more)

Vice Admiral R Hari Kumar, PVSM, AVSM, VSM took over as the Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief (FOC-in-C) of the Western Naval Command on 28 Feb 2021 at Mumbai. He succeeds Vice Admiral Ajit Kumar, PVSM, AVSM, VSM, who retires upon superannuation, after an illustrious career, spanning forty years, in the Indian Navy.



At a ceremony held at the Command Post of Headquarters, Western Naval Command, the outgoing and incoming Commanders-in-Chief were accorded a Guard of Honour after which the formal handing-taking over took place with the handing over of the baton to the new Commander-in-Chief. On assuming command Vice Admiral Hari Kumar laid a wreath at the Gaurav Stambh monument.

Vice Admiral R Hari Kumar, an alumnus of the National Defence Academy was commissioned into the Indian Navy on 01 Jan 1983. He specialised in Gunnery and has commanded five ships including a Destroyer and the aircraft carrier INS Viraat. He has held important staff appointments both ashore and afloat and has also been Naval Advisor to Government of Seychelles. On promotion to flag rank he has held the appointments of Commandant of Naval War College at Goa, Flag Officer Sea Training, Flag Officer Commanding Western Fleet, Chief of Staff at Western Naval Command and Chief of Personnel at NHQ. The Flag Officer is a recepient of the Vishist Seva Medal, Ati Vishisht Seva Medal and Param Vishisht Seva Medal for distinguished service.(Read more)

Most health insurance provides no-claim bonus for claim-free years but that usually ranges from 25 per cent to 50 per cent.
